Watermain Replacement, Road Resurfacing on Scarlett Road

from Richview Road to Lawrence Ave. West, Westbank Crescent, Riverlea Drive and Riverlea Road

Road Resurfacing Start Date: April 6, 2016
End Date: July 2016

The City of Toronto has completed the watermain replacement on Scarlett Road from Richview Road to Lawrence Ave West, on Westbank Crescent and Riverlea Drive (see map).

Starting **April 6, 2016** the contractor will start the final stages of work involving sidewalk, curbs and driveway and catch basin repairs, road resurfacing and any landscaping repairs affected by the watermain work. Road resurfacing work will start on the Scarlett Rd north bound lanes followed by the south bound lanes. Prior to resurfacing, the contractor will address curbs, catch basins and sidewalks. The top asphalt course will be completed on all lanes of Scarlett Road once the base asphalt course has been completed first. Once Scarlett Road is complete, resurfacing will move to the local roads (Westbank Crescent, Riverlea Drive and Riverlea Road).

There will be ongoing localized lane closures on Scarlett Road to facilitate the road resurfacing. We recognize that a project of this nature is disruptive to the community and apologize for the inconveniences caused by the delayed end date.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard), such as landscaping and / or decorative objects. The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.</p> <p>Traffic on Scarlett Road may be reduced to one lane in each direction at times when required.</p>
	<p>Parking: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner. If your vehicle is moved, please contact parking control for its location at 416-808-2222.</p> <p><i>In the event you receive a traffic ticket for on-street parking during this period of construction, please immediately contact Taras Pawluk (416-806-1763), so that your ticket can be cancelled.</i></p> <p>Please note that parking tickets cannot be cancelled if vehicles were parked in illegal parking spots such as in front of a fire hydrant or in no parking zones, or if they are submitted later than three days after receipt.</p>

	<p>TTC Service: This project may affect travel times on the 79 Scarlett Road bus. Visit ttc.ca for accurate schedule information.</p>
	<p>Garbage & Recycling: Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. <i>Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.</i></p>
	<p>Restoration: This portion of the work is the restoration from the watermain construction that started in 2015.</p>

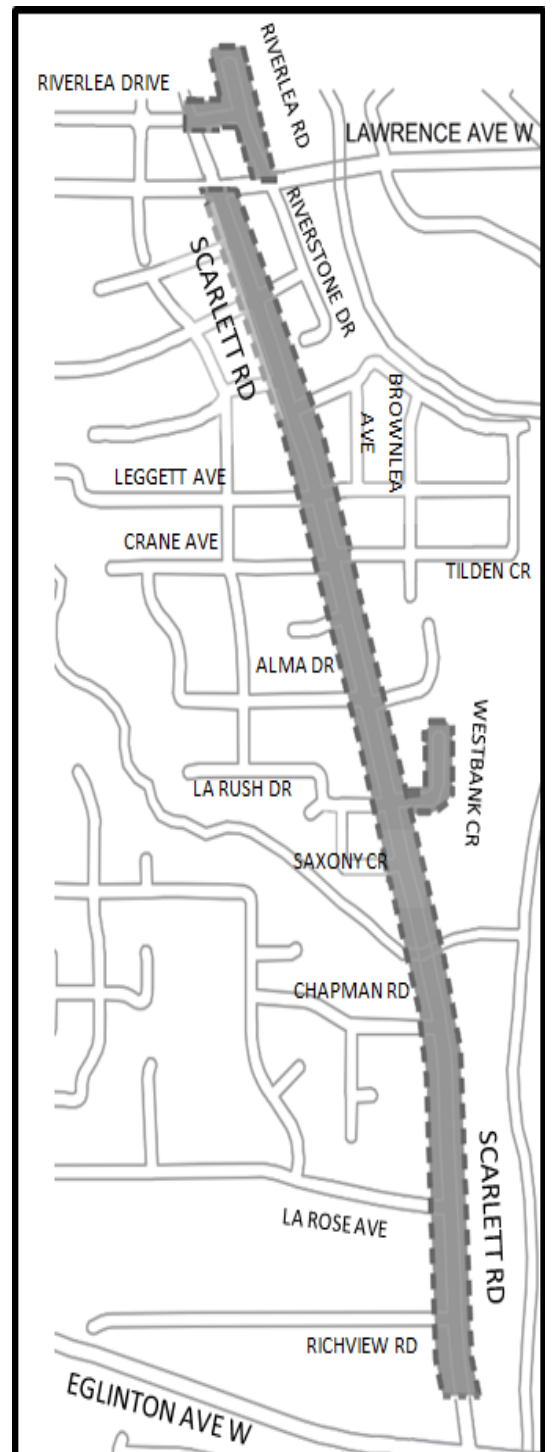
MAP OF WORK AREA
