Laneway Reconstruction South of Lake Shore Boulevard West (East of Tenth Street and East of Sixth Street) Parking Restrictions on Laneways

Due to the work to reconstruct the Laneways – Lane S Lakeshore E Tenth Street and Lane S Lakeshore E Sixth Street, there will be no access to the laneways as follows:

Lane S Lakeshore E Tenth Street from July 20, 2016 to August 5, 2016

Lane S Lakeshore E Sixth Street from August 8, 2016 to August 26, 2106

Residents on these laneways will be permitted to park on the side streets. **Please place this notice in your windshield.**

We do apologize for this inconvenience and appreciate your patience during reconstruction of laneways.

PARKING TICKET ACTION

In the event you receive a traffic ticket for on-street parking during laneways construction, please complete the following steps:



1. *Please write your name, the word "Resident of XXXX Street" on the face of the ticket.*
2. *Please hand in the original hard copy of the ticket to our construction inspector on site, within 3 days of receipt of ticket.*
3. *Contact the Project Manager or construction Inspector.*

Please note that there will be no consideration for offences such as "Stopping on Sidewalks, Parking on Boulevards, Fire Hydrants, Fire Routes or Rush Hour Route restrictions".
