Bridge Repair Queen's Drive Bridge Over Black Creek Drive

Expected Start Date: Fall 2016


Expected End Date: Winter 2016

This fall, the City of Toronto will repair the damage to the Queen's Drive Bridge caused by an accident in 2015. This work will ensure that the bridge meets today's standards and remains safe for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. Upon completion of this project, the Queen's Drive Bridge will fully reopen from the current single lane to full two-lane traffic.

The project is part of the Council-approved 2016 Capital Works Program.

WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- A Construction notice with additional project details will be delivered to the area approximately two weeks before work begins.

- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.

	<p>Work Hours: In order to minimize traffic disruption and congestion, work on this project will take place on weekends only.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Black Creek Drive Northbound will be closed from Friday evening 22:00 p.m. to Monday mornings 5:00 a.m. Black Creek Drive Southbound will be open at all times. Queen's Drive Bridge will be closed from Friday evening 18:00 p.m. to Monday morning 6:00 a.m. Queen's Drive from Jane Street to Venice Drive will be closed (with local access only) during construction.
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work area.</p> <p>Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p>
	<p>Accessible Accommodation: Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, etc) must contact the Project Manager to arrange for access during the construction period.</p>
