Watermain Replacement Cranbrooke Avenue

Expected Start Date: July 2015
Expected Completion Date: June 2016

The City of Toronto will be replacing the watermain on Cranbrooke Avenue. This work will also involve replacing the City-owned portion of substandard water services. This project is part of the 2015 Capital Works Program.

Work will take place on **Cranbrooke Avenue** from 75 m west of Barse Street to Grey Road.

Further notice will be provided before construction starts with a more accurate start date. Your co-operation and patience during the construction is crucial and appreciated.

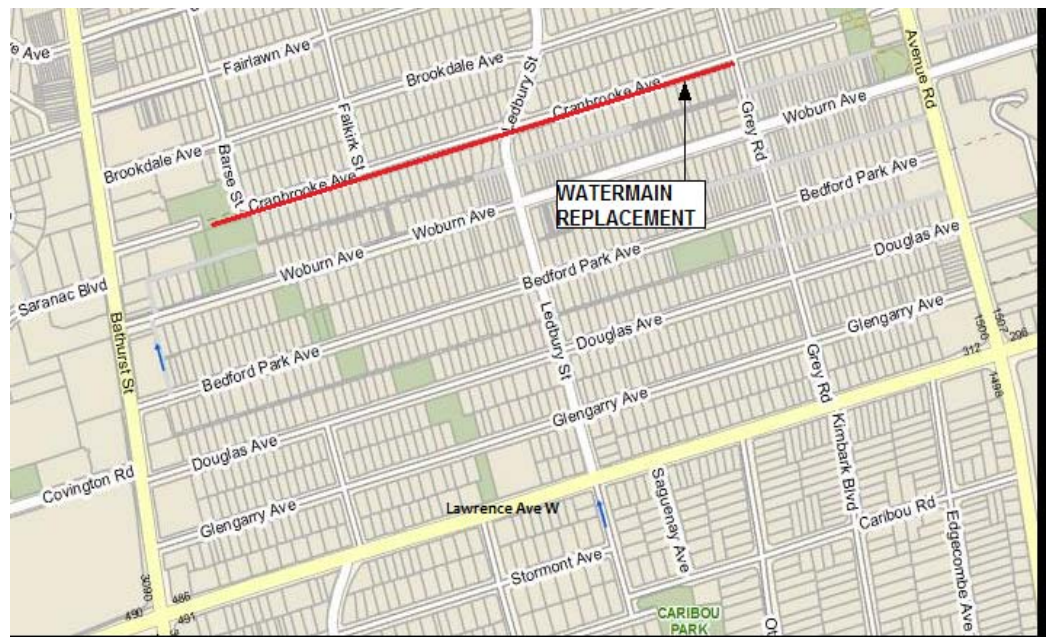
Map of Work Area

Project Details

This project involves:

- Replacing the existing watermain with new pipes
- Replacing the City-owned portion of substandard water services
- Reinstating of the boulevards, and driveways impacted by construction

Temporary lane closures and parking restrictions near the construction zone are required, but local access and emergency traffic will be maintained at all times.



Many property owners have planted landscaping, fences, irrigation systems or other physical features in front of their home which are within the City property limits. These may be in the way of the construction. In such cases, residents are advised to remove these items prior to the beginning of construction in order to avoid unnecessary damage. The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items installed on the City's property.

Disruptions during Construction

In order to complete the watermain replacement and water service replacement in a safe manner, it will be necessary to reduce traffic lanes. Access to driveways will be interrupted from time to time during construction. The contractor is obligated to notify residents and businesses of any temporary driveway closures.
