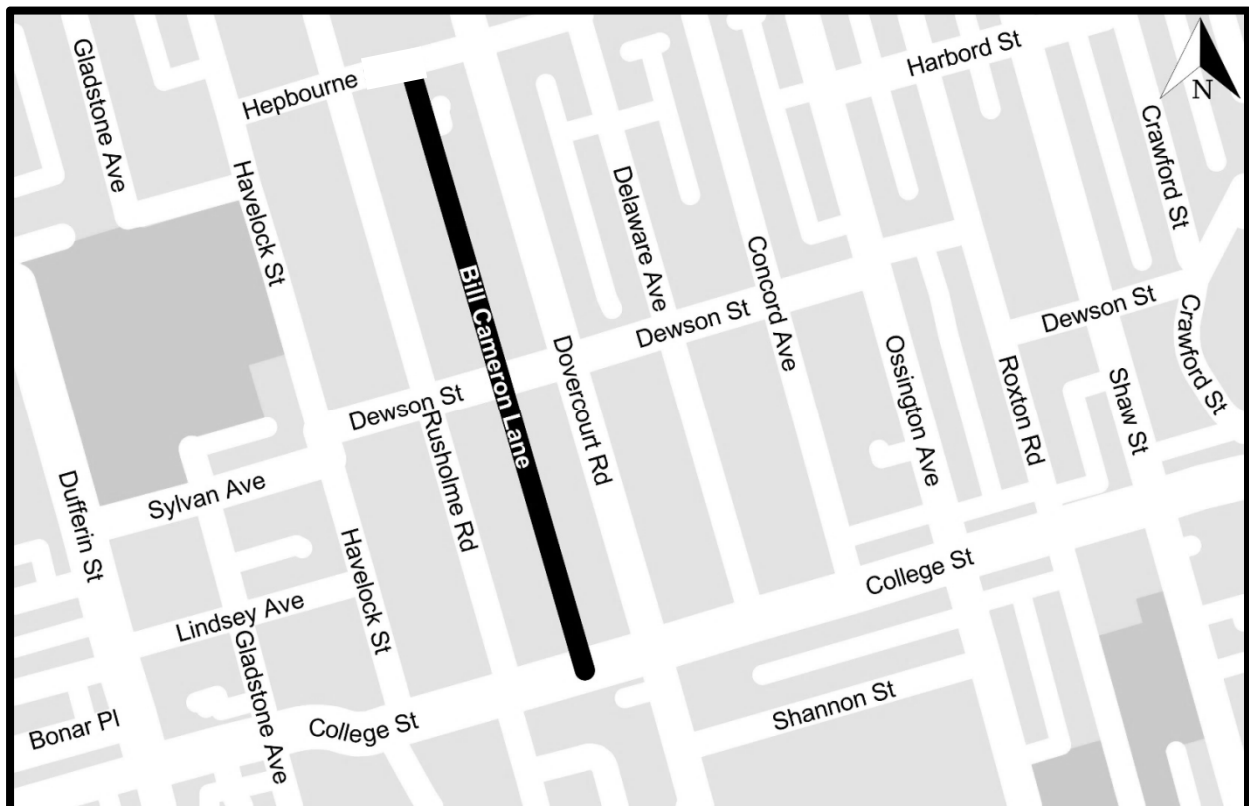

The City of Toronto will reconstruct Bill Cameron Lane in two (2) phases. Phase 1 will be from Hepbourne Street to Dewson Street and Phase 2 will be from Dewson Street to College Street.

This project is part of the Council-approved 2016 Capital Works Program to renew aging city laneways for current and future needs.

WORK DETAILS

The City's contractor will move equipment on-site and prepare the work area before construction begins. Construction crews will then:

- Dig up the laneway surface.
- Reconstruct the laneway.
- Restore all areas affected by work (asphalt, concrete, grass, etc.)

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You will experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. Your patience is appreciated.
- Property owners should remove items located within City property limits, such as landscaping and / or decorative objects.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents.</p> <p>The laneway will be closed for approximately 21 days for Phase 1 & 16 days for Phase 2 during the construction period.</p>
	<p>Parking: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner. If your vehicle is moved, please contact parking control for its location at 416-808-2222.</p> <p>Temporary Parking Permits: If the active work zone blocks your garage or the location of your primary resident parking, the City will attempt to provide a temporary parking permit. This permit will be delivered to you based on availability. In the event that a permit is not issued, please arrange for an alternative parking location or follow the directions below.</p>
	<p>Garbage & Recycling: Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. <i>Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.</i></p>
	<p>Restoration: The construction work area will be restored with sod and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed from public and private property during construction will be replaced.</p>
