## Bent Inspections and Chipping on the F. G. Gardiner Expressway from Exhibition Place to Lower Jarvis Street

The City of Toronto is completing its second round of bent inspections and chipping operations on the underside of the Gardiner Expressway. This work will help the City maintain its aging infrastructure.



### WORK DETAILS

The City's contractor is using boom trucks and platform vehicles to:

- Inspect the condition of the concrete of the expressway's bents
- Remove / chip any loose or areas of concrete to prevent concrete from falling onto the roadway / pedestrian underpasses

### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- This work will result in dust, noise lane restrictions on Lakeshore Boulevard. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. Your patience is appreciated.
- Due to the nature of the work and for worker safety, the machinery has reverse signal beeping, this will be disruptive.

	<p><b>Work Hours:</b> For majority of this project, work will take place from 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. to ensure there is less disruption to traffic and pedestrians during the day.</p>
	<p><b>Traffic Management:</b> Every effort has been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users. Road users may experience some delays due to lane restrictions on Lakeshore Boulevard.</p>
