Tree Removals in Bestview Park October 2016

As part of the 2016 Basement Flooding Protection Program, the City of Toronto will be starting work in your neighbourhood soon. The Basement Flooding Protection work planned in your community will help reduce the damage large storms can cause.

Regretfully, in order to prepare for the extensive upgrade of the existing storm sewer and replacement of the outfall, the City will have to remove some City-owned Trees located in Bestview Park, and well as two trees on Harrington Crescent. All efforts have been made to ensure that as few trees as possible are removed in relation to the construction work.



Information on tree replacement is provided below.

	Work Hours: Tree removal work is scheduled to take place between 7:00 am to 7:00 pm., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.
	Restoration: The tree and its debris will be removed and the site prepared for the upcoming construction work. The two street trees that are being removed will be replaced with a new tree approximately 60 mm at the end of construction on that street. Trees in the Bestview Park ravine area will be replaced with a 3:1 ratio of naturalization planting including tree whips and shrubs.
