## Reconstruction of Old Colony Road Final Design

The City of Toronto will reconstruct Old Colony Road east of Bayview Avenue and a small section of Harrison Road south of Old Colony Road. A small portion of Harrison Road to the dead-end north of Old Colony Road will be resurfaced. This notice provides an update on the final design for Old Colony Road.

### PROJECT HISTORY

The City began working on the preliminary designs for Old Colony Road in 2015. On May 20, 2015 an initial notice was sent to residents along Old Colony Road, and City staff introduced the project to residents at the York Mills Garden Community Association meeting on May 25, 2015. A public information event was held on November 10, 2015, where three (3) design options were presented.

Thank you to everyone who attended the public information event and provided comments on the project.

### FINAL DESIGN



*This image is intended to show what the sidewalk will look like along Old Colony Road. It is not an exact reflection of the design.*

Following discussions with local residents, the City is moving forward with design Option 2, which was presented at the public information event. Option 2 includes a 7.2 m wide road and a sidewalk on the north side of the street along the full length of Old Colony Road. The City has identified an opportunity on Old Colony Road to install non-standard sidewalk concrete unit pavers.


The sidewalk on Old Colony Road will be constructed within the existing road width, so the road will not be widened and impacts to trees will be minimal. The existing standard sidewalk on Harrison Road will be reconstructed in the same vicinity.

The City appreciates the time and work that many residents have dedicated to developing this plan. The collaborative efforts of neighbours along Old Colony Road have resulted in a design that addresses the needs of all road users and is sensitive to the local context.

### CONSTRUCTION

Construction is anticipated to begin in late Summer 2016, and be completed in late Fall 2016. A detailed construction notice will be issued prior to the work commencing.
