## Watermain and Storm Sewer Replacement Prince Andrew Place

**Expected Start Date: June 2015**

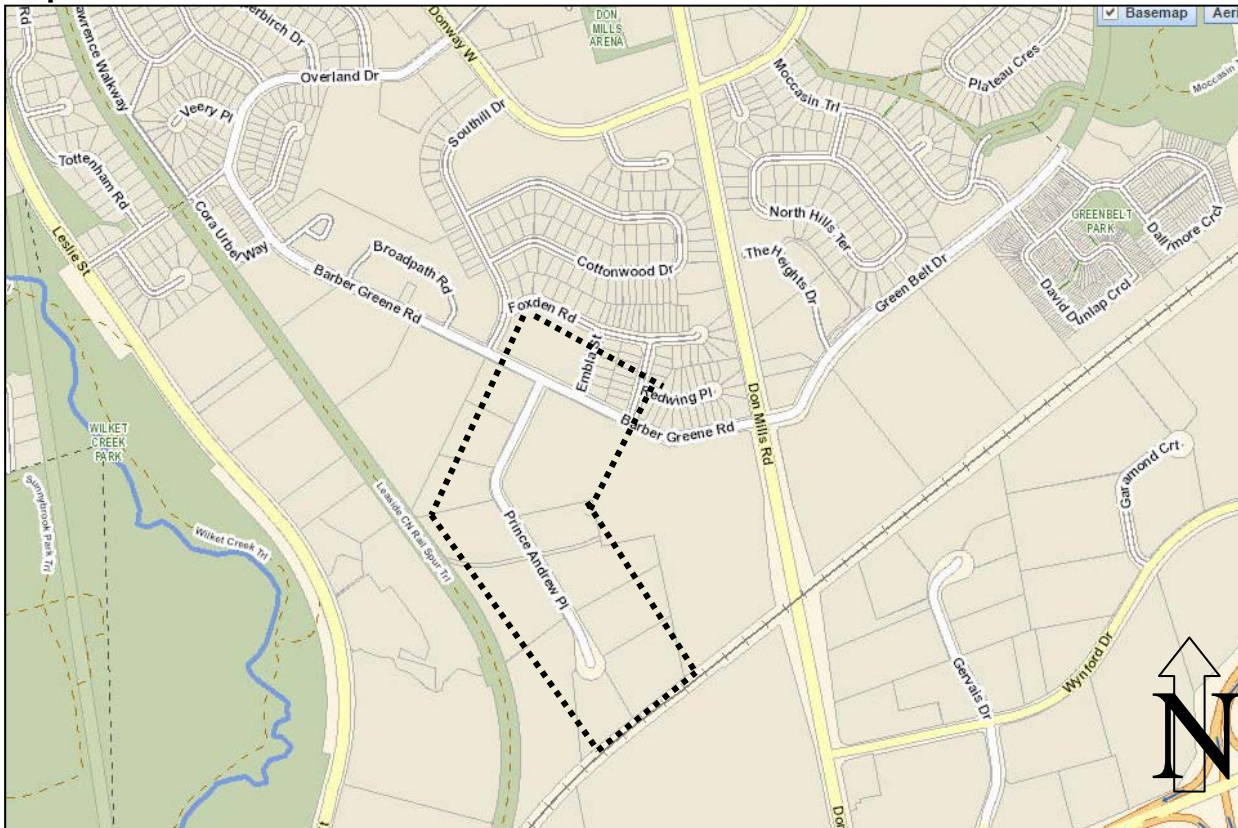
**Expected Completion Date: November 2015**

The City of Toronto will be replacing the watermain and storm sewer on Prince Andrew Place. This work will also involve replacing substandard water services up to the property line, if required.

This work is to take place on Prince Andrew Place from Barber Greene Road to the South End and on an Easement from 23 m West of Prince Andrew Place to 91 m East of Prince Andrew Place.

Further notice will be provided before construction starts with a more accurate start date. Your co-operation and patience during the construction is crucial and appreciated.

### Project Details

The project includes:

- Replacing the existing watermain
- Replacing the City-owned portion of water services and substandard water services.
- Replacing the existing storm water sewer
- Reinstating of the boulevards, roadway and driveways impacted by construction.

Many property owners have planted landscaping, fences, irrigation systems or other physical features in front of their home which are within the City property limits. These may be in the way of the construction. In such cases, residents are advised to remove these items prior to the beginning of construction in order to avoid unnecessary damage. The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items installed on the City's property.

### Disruptions during Construction

In order to complete the watermain, storm sewer and services in a safe manner, it will be necessary to reduce traffic lanes. Local access and emergency traffic will be maintained at all times. Access to driveways will be interrupted from time to time during construction. The contractor is obligated to notify residents and businesses of any temporary driveway closures.
