This notice provides an update on construction activities to be carried out in August at Gerrard Street East and Jarvis Street.



AUGUST 5-8 (7:00 PM ON AUGUST 5TH UNTIL AUGUST 8TH AT 7:00 A.M.)

Work will include reconstructing the south half of the intersection at Gerrard Street and Jarvis Street.

	<p>Working Hours: Friday August 5 – 7:00 P.M to 5:00 A.M (Road Excavation) Saturday August 6 – 7:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M (Concrete Road Base Construction) Sunday August 7 – No Work Monday August 8 – 3:00 A.M. to 7:00 A.M (Base Asphalt Paving)</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: The work requires a north / south closure of Jarvis Street between Gerrard and Dundas with local access only. Traffic going southbound from Carlton Street along Jarvis Street will be required to turn left or right on Gerrard Street due to the intersection work.</p>



AUGUST 12-15 (7:00 PM ON AUGUST 12TH UNTIL AUGUST 15TH AT 7:00 A.M.)

The work includes reconstructing the north half of the intersection at Gerrard Street and Jarvis Street

	<p>Working Hours: Friday August 12 – 7:00 P.M to 5:00 A.M (Road Excavation) Saturday August 13 – 7:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M (Concrete Road Base Construction) Sunday August 14 – No Work Monday August 15 – 3:00 A.M. to 7:00 A.M (Base Asphalt Paving)</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: The work requires a north / south closure of Jarvis Street between Gerrard and Dundas with local access only. Traffic going southbound from Carlton Street along Jarvis Street will be required to turn left or right on Gerrard Street due to the intersection work.</p>

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard), such as landscaping and / or decorative objects. If you have a sprinkler system within the boulevard, please contact the Project Manager
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.

	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions in the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p>Cyclist Information: <i>Due to the nature of the work on Gerrard Street, there is not enough road width to complete construction and maintain cycling lanes in the work zones.</i> Cyclists are encouraged to share the lane through the phased, construction work zones.</p> <p>Alternatively, Cyclists may choose to adjust their routes, so that they travel on Wellesley Street instead.</p>
