

The City of Toronto will be completing rehabilitation work on the Sherbourne Street Bridge over Rosedale Valley Road.

This work will ensure that the bridge meets today's standards and remains safe for vehicles and pedestrians into the future.

### WORK DETAILS

The contractor will

- Replace the asphalt and waterproofing on the bridge deck
- Replace the expansion joint on the bridge deck
- Perform structural steel repairs
- Clean and coat all structural steel
- Repair areas of deteriorated concrete on the bridge

### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.



**Work Hours:** Work on this project will take place from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.

	<p><b>Sidewalk Access:</b> In order to complete work in a safe manner, one of the two sidewalks on Sherbourne Street will be closed.</p> <p><b>From May to July:</b> Work will take place on the east side of Sherbourne Street. The east sidewalk will be closed</p> <p><b>From July to September:</b> Work will take place on the west side of Sherbourne Street. The west sidewalk will be closed Signs will be installed so pedestrians know which sidewalk is open at Bloor Street.</p> <p>On Rosedale Valley Road, pedestrians will use an enclosed hoarding tunnel on the pathway below the bridge.</p>
	<p><b>Traffic Management:</b> Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sherbourne Street will be reduced to one lane in each direction from <b>May to September</b>. The work zone will shift from the east side of the bridge to the west side of the bridge during construction and the road lanes will shift away from the work zone.</li> <li>• Short duration lane restrictions outside of the morning and evening rush hours will occur on Rosedale Valley Road as required throughout construction (January to October).</li> </ul>
	<p><b>Cyclists:</b> The cycle lane on Sherbourne Street over the bridge will be closed from <b>May to September</b>. Cyclists are asked to share the traffic lane in the active work zone.</p>
	<p><b>Restoration:</b> Areas affected by construction will be restored.</p>
