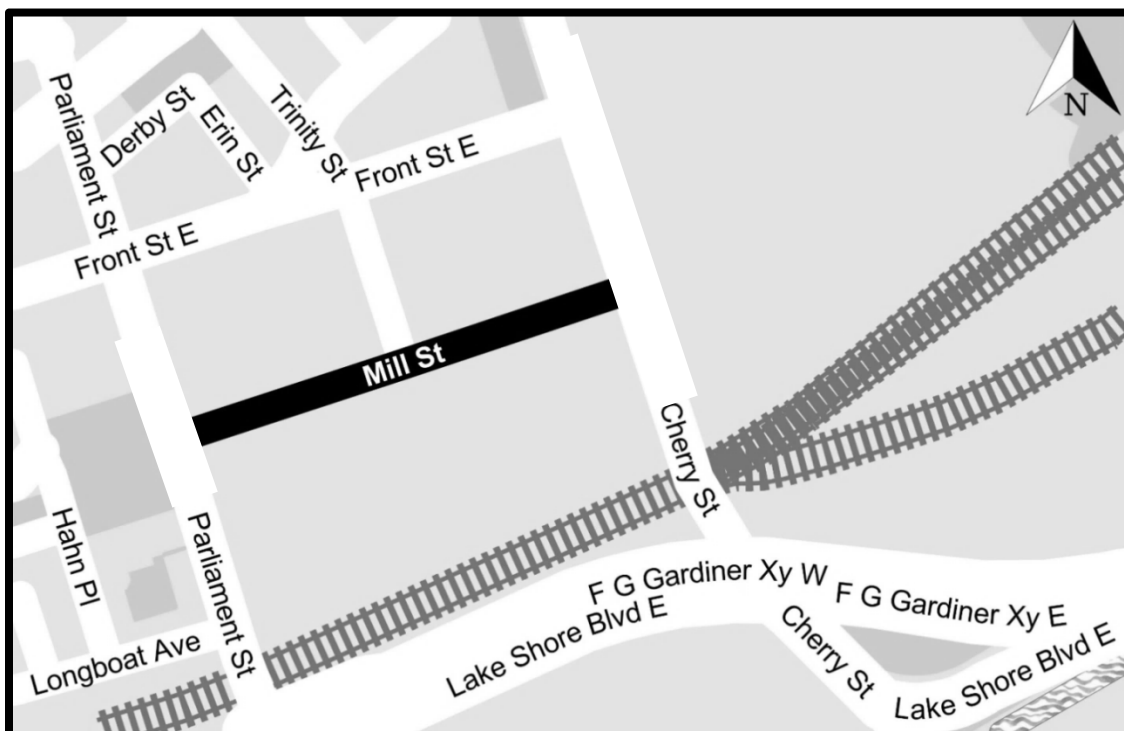

As previously planned, the City of Toronto will be returning to Mill Street to complete the watermain and City-owned portion of substandard water service replacement works as well as reconstruct the road with streetscaping improvements from Parliament Street to Cherry Street.

This project is part of the Council-approved 2016 Capital Works Program to improve water distribution and renew aging city roads and sidewalk for current and future needs.

WORK DETAILS

The City's contractor will re-stage the worksite to:







- Complete the remaining watermain replacement work
- Complete City-owned water service replacements from the watermain to the property line
- Complete streetscaping and road reconstruction work
- Remove and replace the existing traffic signals at the Mill/Parliament intersection

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard), such as landscaping, fencing, irrigation systems and / or decorative objects.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.



Work Hours: Work will take place from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.

	<p>Water Service Disruptions: From time-to-time, the water supply to your property may be shut-off to complete construction; the contractor will provide at least 24-hour advance notice. Throughout the work, it is recommended that you temporarily disconnect any water treatment systems (i.e. softeners or filters), water-cooled air conditioners or similar plumbing fixtures. Automatic lawn sprinkler systems may also be affected, therefore, you may need to water manually. In the event you did not receive advanced notice, an emergency water shut off could have been necessary.</p>
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.</p> <p>Traffic on Mill Street will be <u>westbound only</u> for the duration of construction and will be reduced to one lane when required.</p>
	<p>Parking: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner. If your vehicle is moved, please contact parking control for its location at 416-808-2222.</p> <p>Note: There will be <u>No Parking</u> available on Mill Street from Parliament Street to Cherry Street from <u>6:00am March 13, 2017 to June 30, 2017</u>.</p>
	<p>TTC Service: This project may affect travel times on the Westbound 121 Fort York-Esplanade Route. Visit <i>ttc.ca</i> for <i>accurate schedule information</i>.</p>
	<p>Garbage & Recycling: Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. <i>Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.</i></p>
