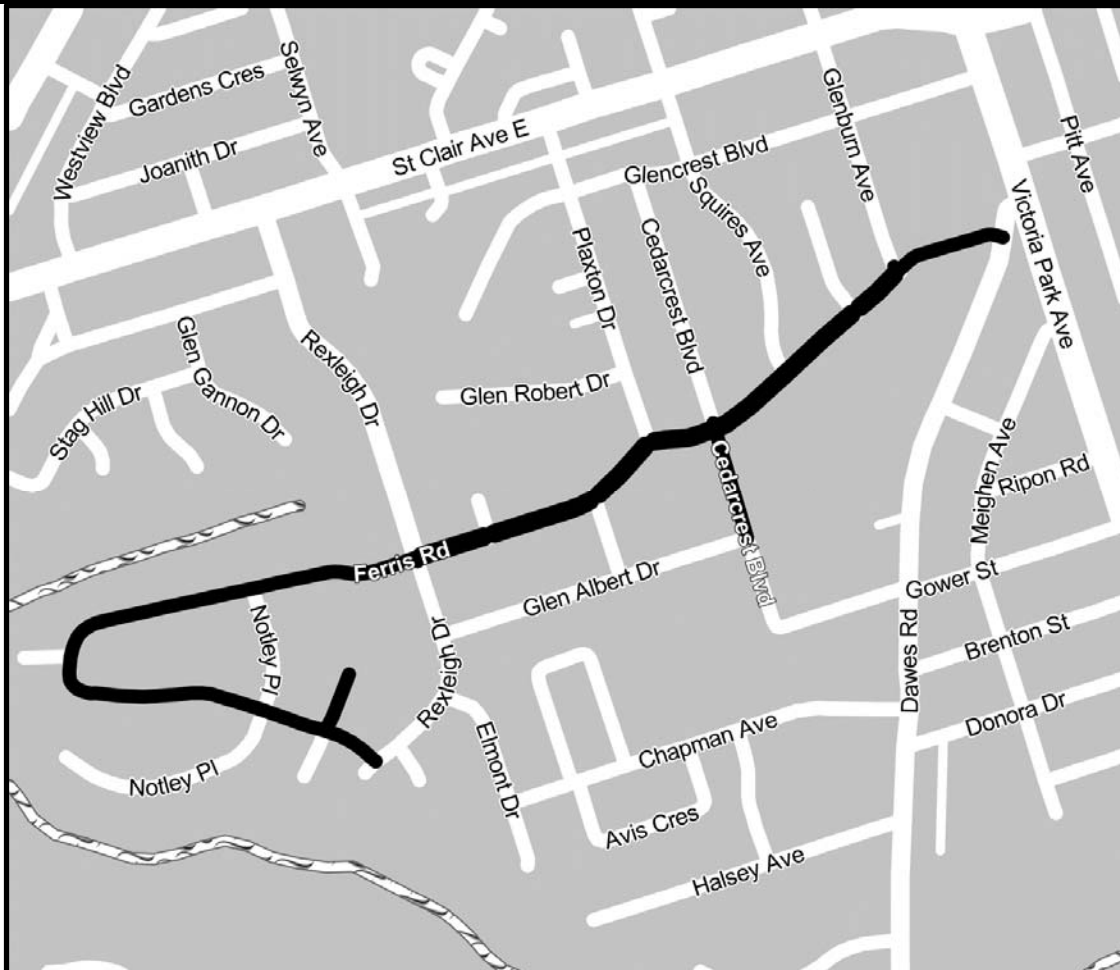

Work on the replacing the watermain and substandard water services in your area is coming to an end. While we anticipated completion by July 29, we encountered unforeseen road base repairs and high temperatures prevented us from completing work on time. Crews will now be finished by August 12, 2016.

Restoration activities have started, as a result, there will be ongoing local lane closures along Ferris Road between Sprucedale Place to Dawes Road as final paving is completed.

We recognize that a project of this nature is disruptive to the community and appreciate your patience.

WORK UPDATE

To date the contractor has:

- Installed the new watermain
- Replaced substandard water services
- Replaced sidewalk, driveways and curb affected by work
- Replaced sod affected by work
- Restored Ferris Rd. from the south end of Rexleigh Drive to just past Sprucedale Place






Restoration work involves:

- Restoring (laying asphalt over the watermain trench) on Ferris Rd. from Sprucedale Place to Dawes Rd.

All restoration should be completed by the end of day, August 12, 2016.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences while restoration work continues.

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work area.</p> <p>Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Accommodation: Residents that require accommodation must contact the Field Ambassador to arrange for access during the construction period.</p>
	<p>Parking: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner. Please contact parking control for the location of your vehicle at 416-808-2222.</p> <p><i>In the event you receive a traffic ticket for on-street parking during this period of construction, please immediately contact the Field Ambassador listed below, so that your tickets can be cancelled.</i></p> <p>Please note that parking tickets cannot be cancelled if vehicles have parked in illegal parking spots such as hydrant violations or no parking zones or if they are submitted to the Construction Inspector later than three days of receipt.</p>
	<p>Garbage & Recycling: Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. <i>Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.</i></p>
	<p>TTC Service: This project may affect travel times on the 23 Dawes Road bus route. Visit ttc.ca for accurate schedule information.</p>
