


HELP PLAN TRANSIT IN TORONTO

The City of Toronto, TTC, Waterfront Toronto together with Metrolinx are working to bring more transit to communities across the city with connections throughout the Greater Toronto and Hamilton Area.

During May and June, we have organized meetings for you to learn more about integrated transit planning and provide your feedback on key transit studies underway.

	<p>SMARTTRACK AND GO REGIONAL EXPRESS RAIL</p> <p>Updates will be presented for integration of SmartTrack and GO Regional Express Rail to improve rapid transit service on three GO corridors in Toronto. Options for extension of the Eglinton Crosstown LRT west to Pearson Airport will also be discussed.</p>
<p>RELIEF LINE</p> <p>Results of the evaluation of alignment options will be presented, including proposed locations for stations entrances.</p>	<p>SCARBOROUGH TRANSIT PLANNING</p> <p>Updates of the evaluation of options for the Scarborough Subway Extension will be presented. Options for an LRT connecting Kennedy Station and the University of Toronto, Scarborough Campus along Eglinton Avenue, Kingston Road and Morningside Avenue will also be presented.</p>
<p>WATERFRONT TRANSIT "RESET"</p> <p>The vision for a comprehensive waterfront transit network will be introduced. Preliminary transit concepts and their associated evaluation framework will be introduced and discussed.</p>
