## Road Reconstruction on Hartismere Court & Road Resurfacing on Collingdale Road

**Contract: 16ECS-TI-104LR**  
**Start Date: September 6, 2016**  
**Original End Date: December 12, 2016**  
**Spring RESTART Date: May 15, 2017**  
**Revised NEW End Date: June 30, 2017**

The City of Toronto is returning to resurface Collingdale Road and reconstruct Hartismere Court.


Road resurfacing involves milling the top layer of road asphalt and replacing top asphalt. Road reconstruction involves removing the asphalt & the granular base layer, replacing the granular layer & placing new asphalt.

This project stopped for the winter because of unplanned delays related to hydro locates and ensuring tree protection was in place.

We had to wait until spring to complete the rest of the work. The road work is resuming soon because paving work requires consistently warmer and drier weather (+7 degrees).

We recognize that a project of this nature is disruptive to the community and apologize for the inconveniences caused by the delayed end date.

### WORK DETAILS

**Before the winter break, the contractor completed the following work:**

- Replaced the curbs on Hartismere Court and where required on Collingdale Road.
- Replaced the sidewalk where required on Collingdale & Hartismere Court.
- Installed a new sidewalk installation on the south side of Hartismere Court between Collingdale and Hartismere Court.
- Investigated and confirmed that the water services on Hartismere Court did not need replacing.

**When work re-starts, the contractor will:**

- Resurface the road on Collingdale Road and reconstruct the road on Hartismere Court.
- Complete all restoration work

	<p><b>Work Hours:</b> Work will take place from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
	<p><b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p><b>Driveway Access:</b> The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p><b>Traffic Management:</b> Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.</p> <p><b>Traffic on Collingdale Road and Hartismere Court will be reduced to one lane when crews are completing work on that street.</b></p>
	<p><b>Parking:</b> Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner. If your vehicle is moved, please contact parking control for its location at <b>416-808-2222</b>.</p>
	<p><b>Garbage &amp; Recycling:</b> Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them.</p> <p><b><i>Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.</i></b></p>
	<p><b>Restoration:</b> The construction work area will be restored with sod and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed from public and private property during construction will be replaced.</p>
