Road Reconstruction on Chapman Road and Arcade Drive Road Resurfacing on Adonis Court


The City of Toronto will be resurfacing the road on Adonis Court and reconstructing Chapman Road & Arcade Drive (see map). They will also be installing new concrete curbs and sidewalk on Adonis Court, installing new concrete curbs on Arcade Drive, installing new concrete curb along sections of Chapman Road east of Arcade Drive and replacing sections of sidewalk where required.

This project had to stop work in the winter because there was a two-month delay in completing the utility locates. Utility Locates are mandatory before any work starts as they identify buried utilities and ensure they are not affected by construction. The project also stopped work for two weeks to work with Urban Forestry to address concerns with the construction process.

We had to wait until spring to complete the rest of the work. The road work is resuming in Spring 2017 because paving work requires consistently warmer and drier weather (+7 degrees).

We recognize that a project of this nature is disruptive to the community and apologize for the inconveniences caused by the delayed end date.

WORK DETAILS

Before the winter break, the contractor:

- The City of Toronto replaced the City-owned portion of any substandard water services on Chapman Road and Arcade Drive.

Starting in April, the contractor will:

- Install new curbs and sidewalk and resurface Adonis Court
- Install new concrete curb on Arcade Drive and Chapman Road east of Arcade Drive
- Reconstruct Chapman Road and Arcade Drive

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard), such as landscaping and / or decorative objects.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.</p>
	<p>Parking: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner. If your vehicle is moved, please contact parking control for its location at 416-808-2222.</p>
	<p>Garbage & Recycling: Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. <i>Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.</i></p>
	<p>Restoration: The construction work area will be restored with sod and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed from public and private property during construction will be replaced.</p>
