Road Rehabilitation on Carsbrooke Road and other local roads

Contract: 16ECS-TI-103LR

In 2016, The City of Toronto was been working on roads in your area using the CIREAM (Cold In-Place Recycled Expanded Asphalt Mix) process. This process is an ecological method of road rehabilitation in which the existing asphalt is recycled and placed back down as the asphalt base layer.

Work will take place on these streets (see map):

- Beckenham Court
- Ulverston Road,
- Wareside Road,
- Cambrian Road,
- Guernsey Drive,
- Welkin Gate,
- Groverdale Road, and;
- Carsbrooke Road.

This project had to stop work in the winter because there was a two-month delay in completing the utility locates. Utility Locates are mandatory before any work starts as they identify buried utilities and ensure they are not affected by construction. We had to wait until spring to finish the work because CIREAM process paving work requires consistently warmer and drier weather (+15 degrees). We recognize that a project of this nature is disruptive to the community and apologize for the inconveniences caused by the delayed end date.

WORK DETAILS

Before the winter break, the contractor:

- Replaced all curb & gutter on Carsbrooke Road, Cambrian Road, Welkin Gate, Ulverston Road and Beckenham Court.
- Replaced damaged sidewalk on Carsbrooke Road, Cambrian Road, Welkin Gate, Ulverston Road, Beckenham Court and on Wareside Road south of Ulverston Road.
- Reconstructed Forestone Road (entire road and portions of sidewalk, curb and gutter).

Starting in April, the contractor will:

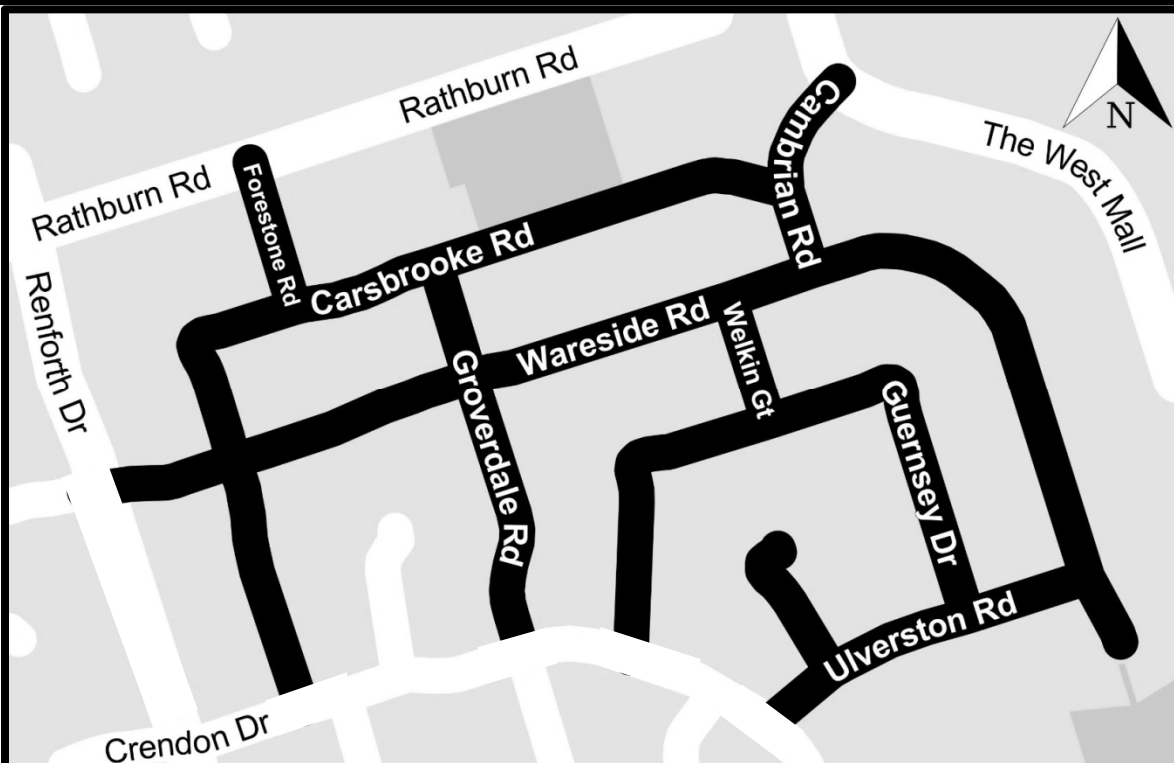
- Replace all curb & gutter on Groverdale Road, Wareside Road and Guernsey Drive.
- Replace damaged sidewalk on Groverdale Road, Wareside Road and Guernsey Drive.
- Rehabilitate roads using the CIREAM process on the streets listed on page 1 the map.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard), such as landscaping and / or decorative objects.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p>Parking: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner. If your vehicle is moved, please contact parking control for its location at 416-808-2222.</p>
	<p>Garbage & Recycling: Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.</p>
	<p>Restoration: The construction work area will be restored with sod and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed from public and private property during construction will be replaced.</p>
