Road Resurfacing on Eglinton Avenue West from Martin Grove Road to Jane Street

Expected Start Date: August 2017

Expected End Date: December 2017



The City of Toronto is planning to resurface Eglinton Avenue West, from 100 metres east of Martin Grove Road, to Jane Street. Our inspection of the road shows that it needs repaving and sections of damaged curb and sidewalk need to be replaced to bring them to a state of good repair. A new sidewalk will be added on the north side of Eglinton between Jane and Scarlett Road.

This work is part of the Council-approved 2017 Capital Works Program to renew aging city roads and sidewalk for current and future needs.

You may receive more than one Pre-Construction or Construction Notice from the City of Toronto. There are a number of projects planned in your community in 2017.

WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark sidewalks and curbs requiring replacement and the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.

- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.
- Work in the boulevard in front of homes and commercial properties is expected. This work includes removing and replacing driveways, municipal sidewalks and grassed boulevards, where necessary.
- Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard), such as landscaping and or decorative objects before work starts. If you have a sprinkler system within the boulevard, please contact the Project Manager listed below.
- Work on this project will be staged in segments to help improve traffic flow and management; extended hours will also be used on this project to help shorten the project duration including overnight work on weekends in some intersections.
- Where possible, in an effort to expedite construction, phases may be extended from that shown on the work area map above.
