Road Resurfacing on Waterford Drive and other local roads

The City's resurfacing work on Corbridge Court, Summitcrest Drive from Waterford Drive to Islington Avenue, Strathdee Drive from Waterford Drive to Wincott Drive, and Waterford Drive from Holgate Street to Wincott Drive is progressing well. This notice provides an update on paving activities.

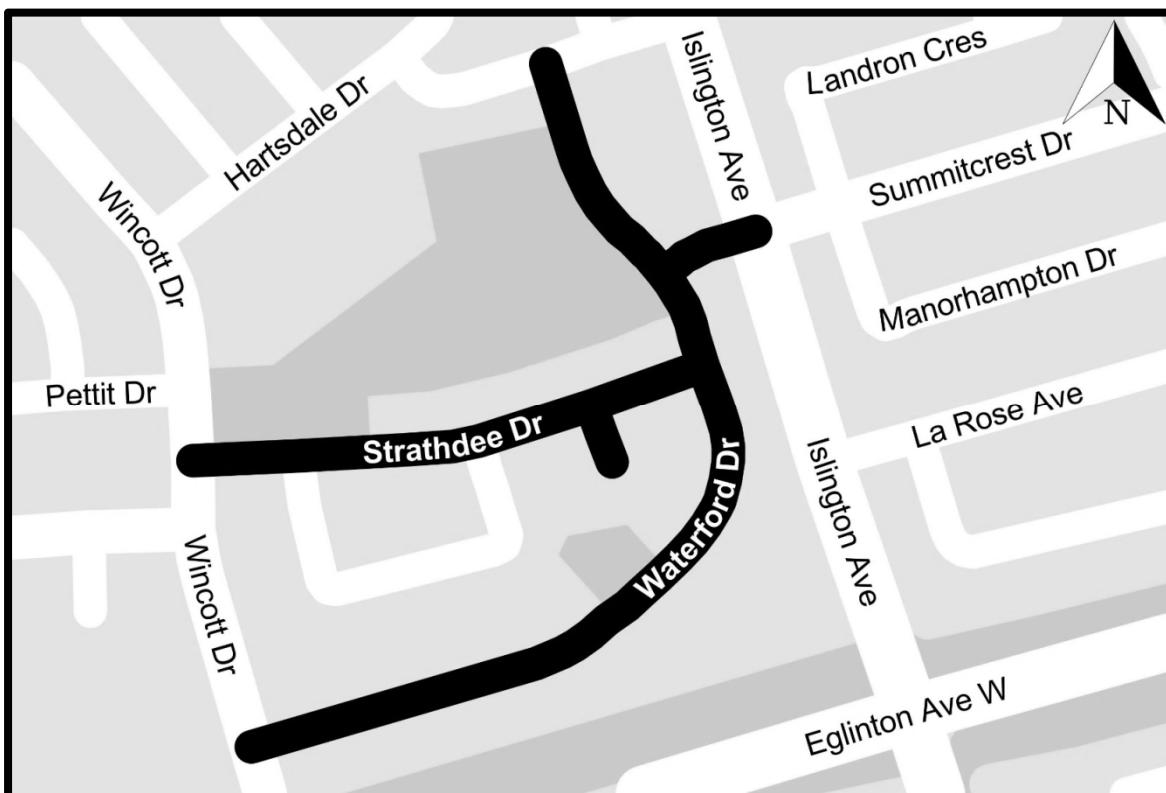
On November 9, 10 & 11 the contractor will be grinding and removing the asphalt road surface on Corbridge Court, Summitcrest Drive from Waterford Drive to Islington Avenue, Strathdee Drive from Waterford Drive to Wincott Drive, and Waterford Drive from Holgate Street to Wincott Drive.

On ***November 16, 17 & 18***, weather permitting, the Contractor will complete the asphalt paving on the above noted roads.

NO PARKING will be permitted on the above noted roads on November 9, 10, 11 & 16, 17, 18 to allow the work to be completed.

We appreciate your patience during this phase of construction.

WORK DETAILS

- Curb and sidewalk repairs will be completed prior to the grinding of the road.
- On November 9, 10 & 11 the work will be disruptive because it involves grinding and milling the asphalt road surface.
- On November 16, 17 & 18, weather permitting, Crews will complete the asphalt paving.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays. Traffic on the streets involved in this work may be limited to one lane or have temporary restrictions when work is taking place.</p> <p>Driveway Access: During paving operations there will be temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p>Parking: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner. If your vehicle is moved, please contact parking control for its location at 416-808-2222.</p> <p>NO STREET PARKING will be permitted November 9, 10, 11 & 16, 17, 18 from 7:00am to 6:00pm</p>
	<p>Garbage & Recycling: Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. <i>Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.</i></p>
	<p>Restoration: The construction work area will be restored with sod and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed from public and private property during construction will be replaced.</p> <p>Sod restoration may be completed in the spring of 2017.</p>
