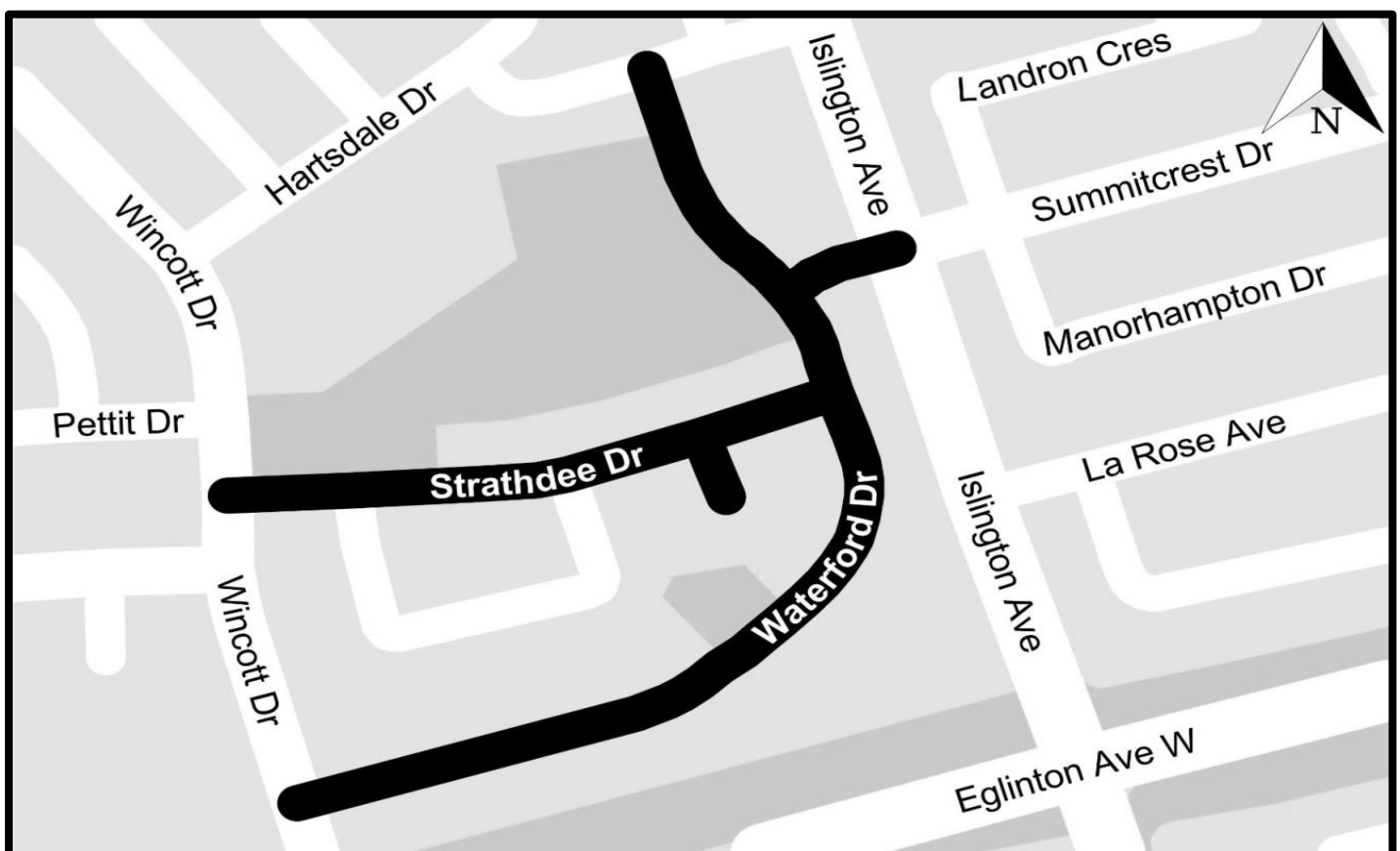

The City will be completing sod restoration activities on Corbridge Court, Summitcrest Drive from Waterford Drive to Islington Avenue, Strathdee Drive from Waterford Drive to Wincott Drive, and Waterford Drive from Holgate Street to Wincott Drive.

This project stopped for the winter because of unplanned delays related to utility locates and ensuring tree protection was in place.

We recognize that a project of this nature is disruptive to the community and apologize for the inconveniences caused by the delayed end date.

WORK DETAILS

Before the winter break, the contractor completed the following work:

- Curb and sidewalk repairs
- Road resurfacing with new asphalt

When work re-starts, the contractor will:

- Complete all restoration work

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.</p> <p>Traffic may be reduced to one lane when crews are completing work on the street.</p>
	<p>Parking: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner. If your vehicle is moved, please contact parking control for its location at 416-808-2222.</p>
	<p>Garbage & Recycling: Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them.</p> <p><i>Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.</i></p>
	<p>Restoration: The construction work area will be restored with sod and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed from public and private property during construction will be replaced.</p>
