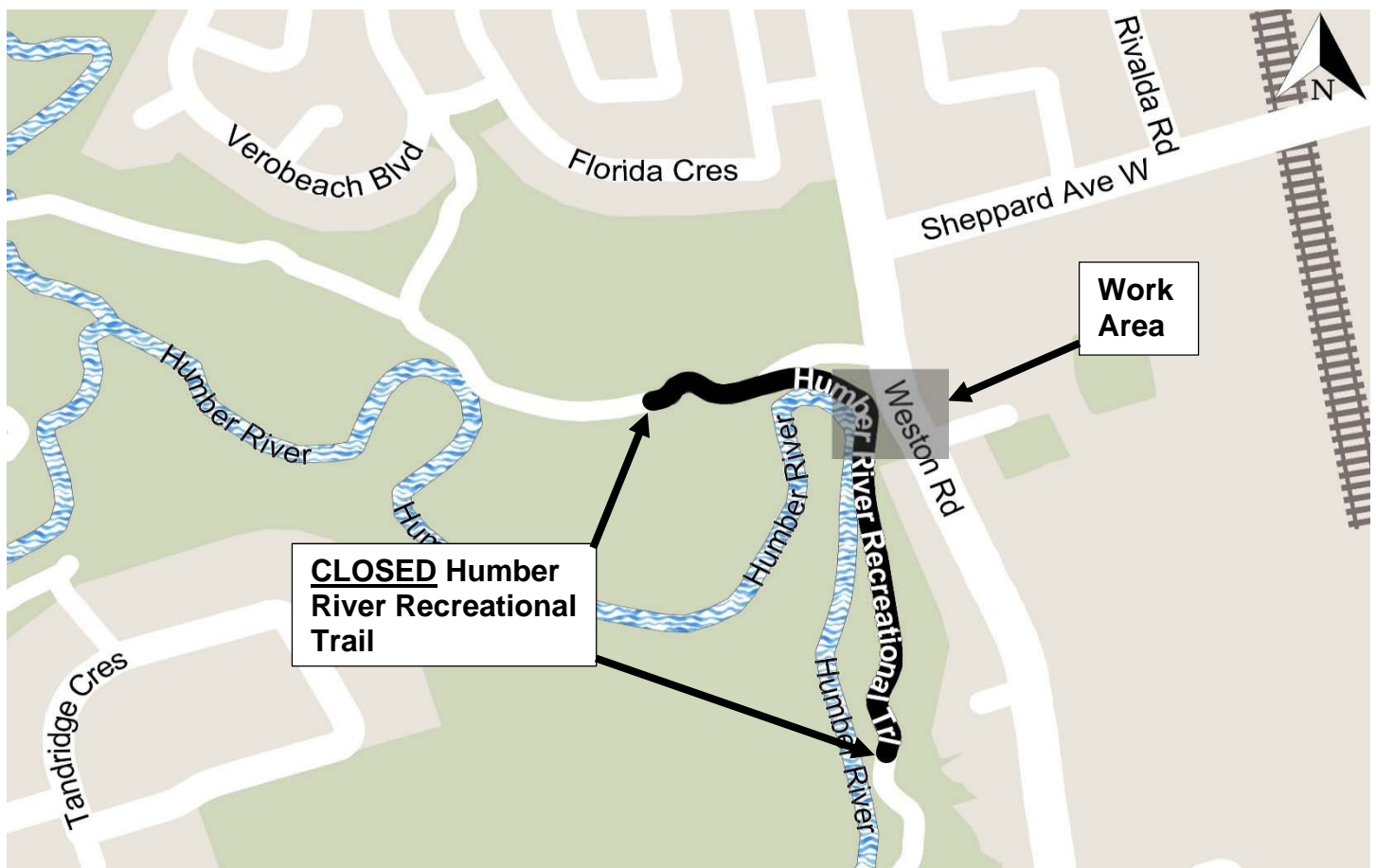

The City of Toronto is planning to replace the storm sewer and Humber River Outfall on the Weston Road Easement (see map). During the construction, part of the Humber River Recreational Trail near the project area will be **CLOSED** as trucks, heavy duty equipment, etc. will be using the trail as an access route.



This work is needed to bring the storm sewer and Humber River outfall to a state of good repair. This project is part of the Council-approved 2017 Capital Works Program to renew aging infrastructure for current and future needs.

WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.

	<p>Pre-Construction Inspection: The contractor will survey all properties within 30 metres the construction area before construction starts. Participation in the survey is voluntary; however, participating is important in determining if the construction caused damage. The inspection will look at both the interior and exterior of all properties to verify existing conditions. All inspection staff will be wearing photo identification and carrying photographic equipment during their work.</p>
	<p>Accessible Accommodation: Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, etc.) must contact the Field Ambassador to arrange for access during the construction period.</p>
