## Road and Utility Improvements Transit Road - Wilson Avenue to W.R. Allen Road

**Expected Start Date: Spring 2016**

**Expected End Date: Fall 2016**

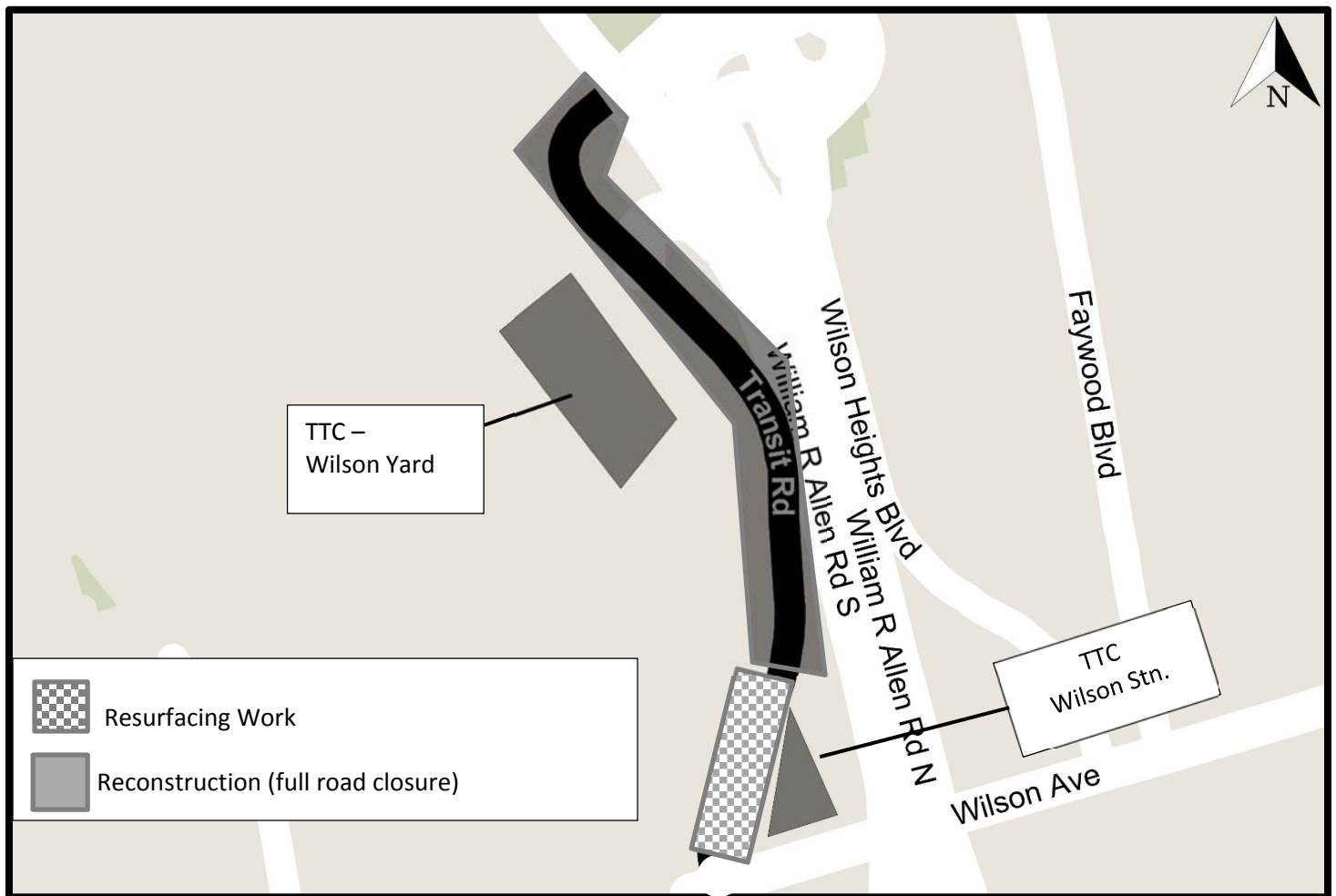

This spring the City of Toronto will start road resurfacing and reconstruction on Transit Road from Wilson Avenue to W.R. Allen Road including the W.R. Allen southbound ramp.

The work includes; major road reconstruction involving firemain installation, and the relocation and new installation of street lighting from 300m north of Wilson Avenue to W.R. Allen Road. Other improvements include; road resurfacing and sidewalk and curb repairs from Wilson Avenue to 300m north of Wilson Avenue, as well as resurfacing the W.R. Allen Road southbound ramp.




This work is needed to bring Transit Road to a state of good repair. This project is part of the Council-approved 2016 Capital Works Program to renew aging infrastructure.

### WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark sidewalks and curbs requiring replacement and the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that construction does not interfere with these utilities.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.

	<p><b>Accommodation:</b> Those who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, etc.) must contact the Field Ambassador to arrange for access during the construction period.</p>
	<p>Transit Road will be closed from 300m north of Wilson Avenue to 20m south of W.R. Allen Road during the construction period.</p> <p>Road access to Transit Road and to the TTC's Wilson Subway Station and Pick-up and Drop-off facility will be maintained only from Wilson Avenue to 300m north of Wilson Avenue.</p>
	<p><b>TTC Service:</b> TTC bus operations/access to and from the Wilson Station will be maintained for the duration of the work. Work will be staged in areas to ensure minimal disruption to TTC bus service.</p>
