Storm Sewer Replacement on Robbie Avenue 40 m West of Graymar Avenue

Expected Start Date: Spring 2017

Expected End Date: Autumn 2017

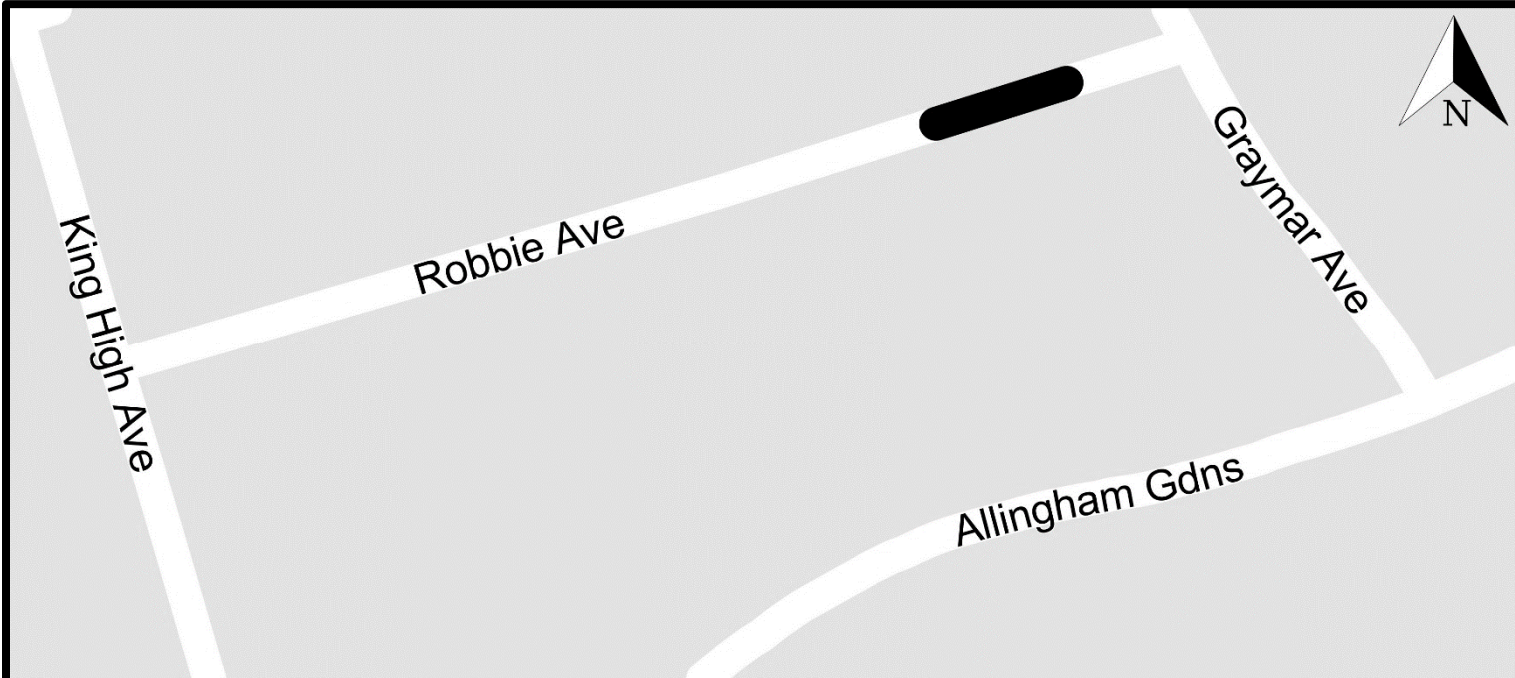

The City of Toronto is planning to replace 4 meters of storm sewer on Robbie Avenue, 40 m west of Graymar Avenue (in front of #7 Robbie Avenue).

The storm sewer is an underground pipe designed to collect stormwater and melting snow and release it into a nearby creek or river.

This project is part of the Council-approved 2017 Capital Works Program that will improve water distribution and the City's aging infrastructure.

WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark the underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable to ensure they are not affected by the work.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.
- Work in the boulevard in front of homes and commercial properties is expected. This work includes removing and replacing driveways, municipal sidewalks and grassed boulevards, where necessary.



Accommodation: Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, etc.) must contact the Field Ambassador to arrange for access during the construction period.
