Sanitary Sewer Replacement on William Street from Rosemount Avenue to west of Wadsworth Boulevard



Last fall, the City of Toronto replaced the sanitary sewer and the City-owned portion of sanitary service laterals and substandard water services on William Street from Rosemount Avenue to 20m West of Wadsworth Boulevard.

With the asphalt plants now open, the City will complete the paving and restoration work on these streets.

WORK DETAILS

Before the winter break, the contractor completed the following work:

- Replaced the sanitary sewer and the City-owned portion of sanitary service laterals and substandard water services on William Street from Rosemount Avenue to 20m West of Wadsworth Boulevard.

When work re-starts, the contractor will:

- Resurface the road on William Street from Rosemount Avenue to 20m West of Wadsworth Boulevard.
- Complete all restoration work to curbs, sidewalks, driveways and lawns

	<p>Work Hours: This project will use work hours from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Saturdays to reduce the project duration.</p>
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions in the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. These efforts include revising traffic signal times and signs. Road users should expect delays and more traffic on nearby streets.</p> <p>At times, traffic on William Street will be reduced to one lane.</p>
	<p>Garbage & Recycling: Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. <i>Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.</i></p>
	<p>Restoration: The construction work area will be restored with sod and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed from public and private property during construction will be replaced. Lawn seeding and/or laying of sod will be done as needed during ideal growing seasons only - in the spring (April to June) and fall (September to October).</p>
