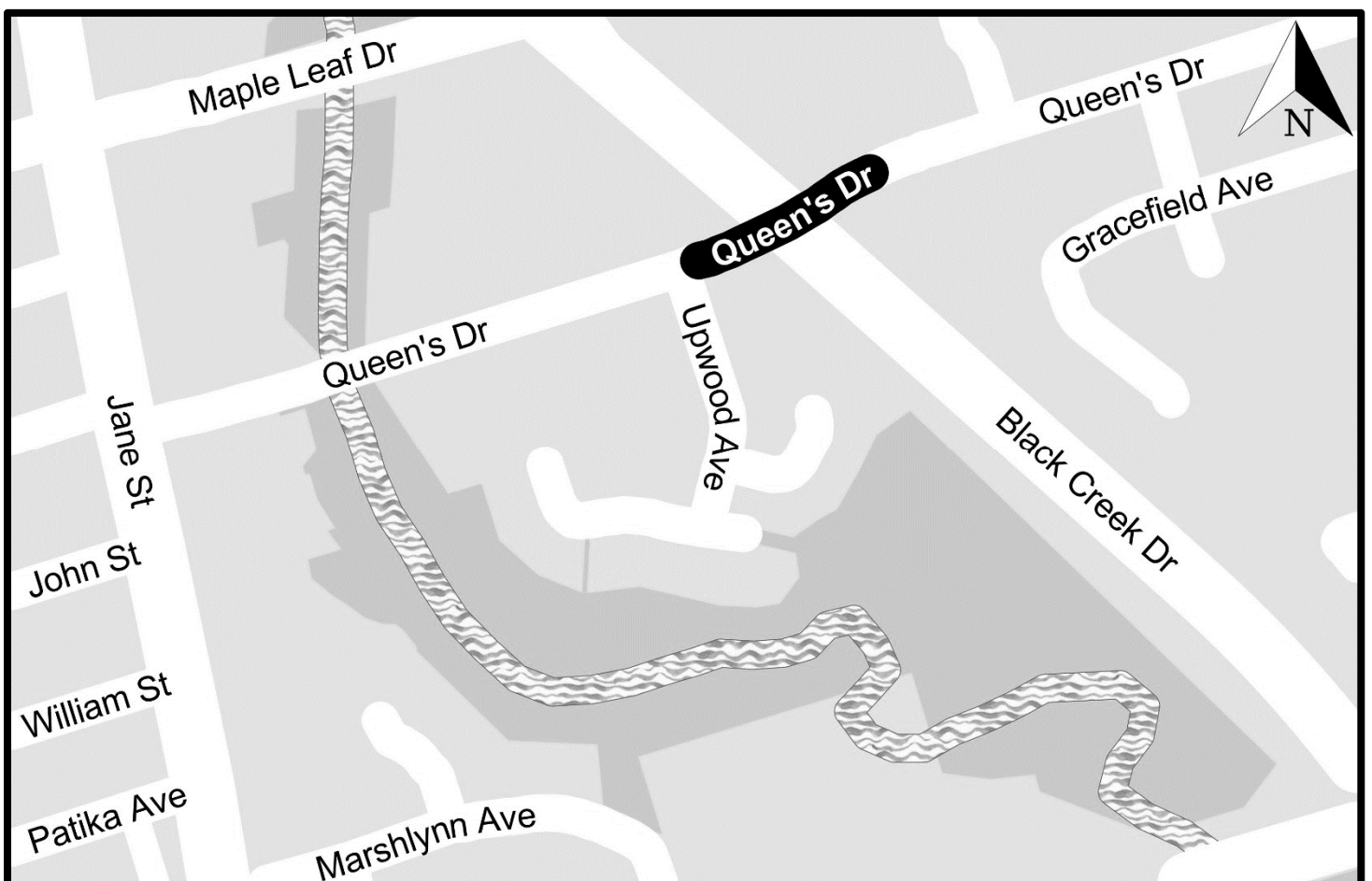
## Bridge Repair Queen's Drive Bridge Over Black Creek Drive

**Contract: #16ECS-TI-11BE**  
**Expected Start Date: November 19, 2016**  
**Expected End Date: December 31, 2016**  
*\*Timeline is subject to change.*

The City of Toronto will repair the damage to the Queen's Drive Bridge caused by an accident in 2015. This work will ensure that the bridge meets today's standards and remains safe for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. Upon completion of this project, the Queen's Drive Bridge will fully reopen from the current single lane to full two-lane traffic.

The project is part of the Council-approved 2016 Capital Works Program.

### WORK DETAILS

The City's contractor will:

- Remove and replace damaged steel beams
- Remove temporary concrete barrier and chain link fences on the bridge and fully open Queens Drive at the bridge
- Restore areas affected by construction

### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	<p><b>24/7 Work Hours:</b> The Contractor on this project will use extended work hours to minimize traffic disruption and congestion and to shorten the project duration.</p> <p>Work on this project will take place on Weekends (Friday evening to Monday morning) only.</p>
	<p><b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work area.</p> <p>A sidewalk/walkway for pedestrian access on the Queens Drive Bridge will remain open at all times.</p>
	<p><b>Traffic Management:</b> Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.</p> <p><b>Black Creek Drive Northbound will be closed on weekends only, from 10:00 p.m. Friday evening to 5:00 a.m. Monday mornings (6 weekends).</b></p> <p>Black Creek Drive Southbound will be open at all times.</p> <p><b>Queen's Drive from Jane Street to Venice Drive will be closed (with local access only) during construction, from 6:00 p.m. Friday evening to 6:00 a.m. Monday mornings (6 weekends).</b></p> <p><b>Queen's Drive from Jane Street to Venice Drive (eastbound) will be one-way only, traffic from Venice Drive to Jane Street (westbound) will be detoured, from Monday 5:00 a.m. to Friday 10:00pm (6 weeks - weekday).</b></p>
	<p><b>Parking:</b> Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner. Please contact parking control for the location of your vehicle at <b>416-808-2222</b>.</p>
	<p><b>Restoration:</b> The bridge work and construction work area, if damaged during construction, will be restored with asphalt and/or concrete where required.</p>
