Storm Sewer Replacement on Dundas Street West from the East Side of the Humber Bridge Descending along Ravine Embankment to outfall on Humber River

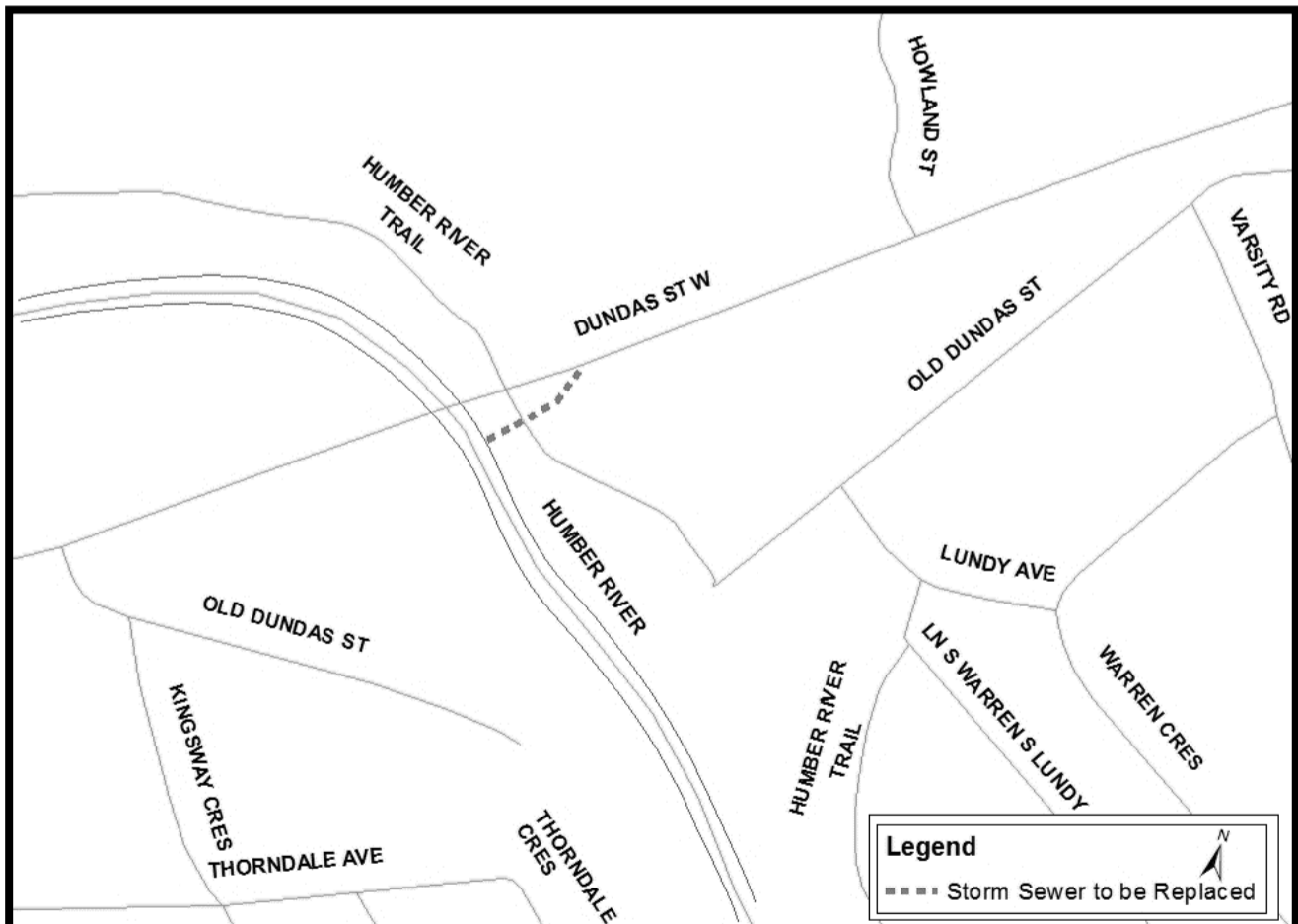

The City of Toronto has completed the storm sewer replacement portion of the project that started in 2016.

Although work has progressed well, the project has been delayed due to the inclement weather causing saturated soil conditions along the ravine slope. The landscaping work along the slope including the installation of ledge blocks and other operations cannot be completed the soil in the area becomes more stable. In addition, planting and hydroseeding along the slope can only take place during the ideal growing season in the fall (September to October) which has added to the delays on the project.

This project is part of the Council-approved 2016 Capital Works Program that will improve stormwater conveyance and the City's aging infrastructure.

WORK UPDATE

- Sewer reconstruction works, road repaving and structural repairs to the bridge (retaining wall and parapet wall) are complete.
- Landscape restoration along the slope started in May 2017 and should be completed by the end of September 2017. Contractor will then clean up the site and demobilize.

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Driveway Access: For residents in the vicinity of 4070 Old Dundas Street, the contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Some of these efforts include adding Local Access signs, revising traffic signal times. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.</p>
	<p>Restoration: The construction work area will be restored.</p>
