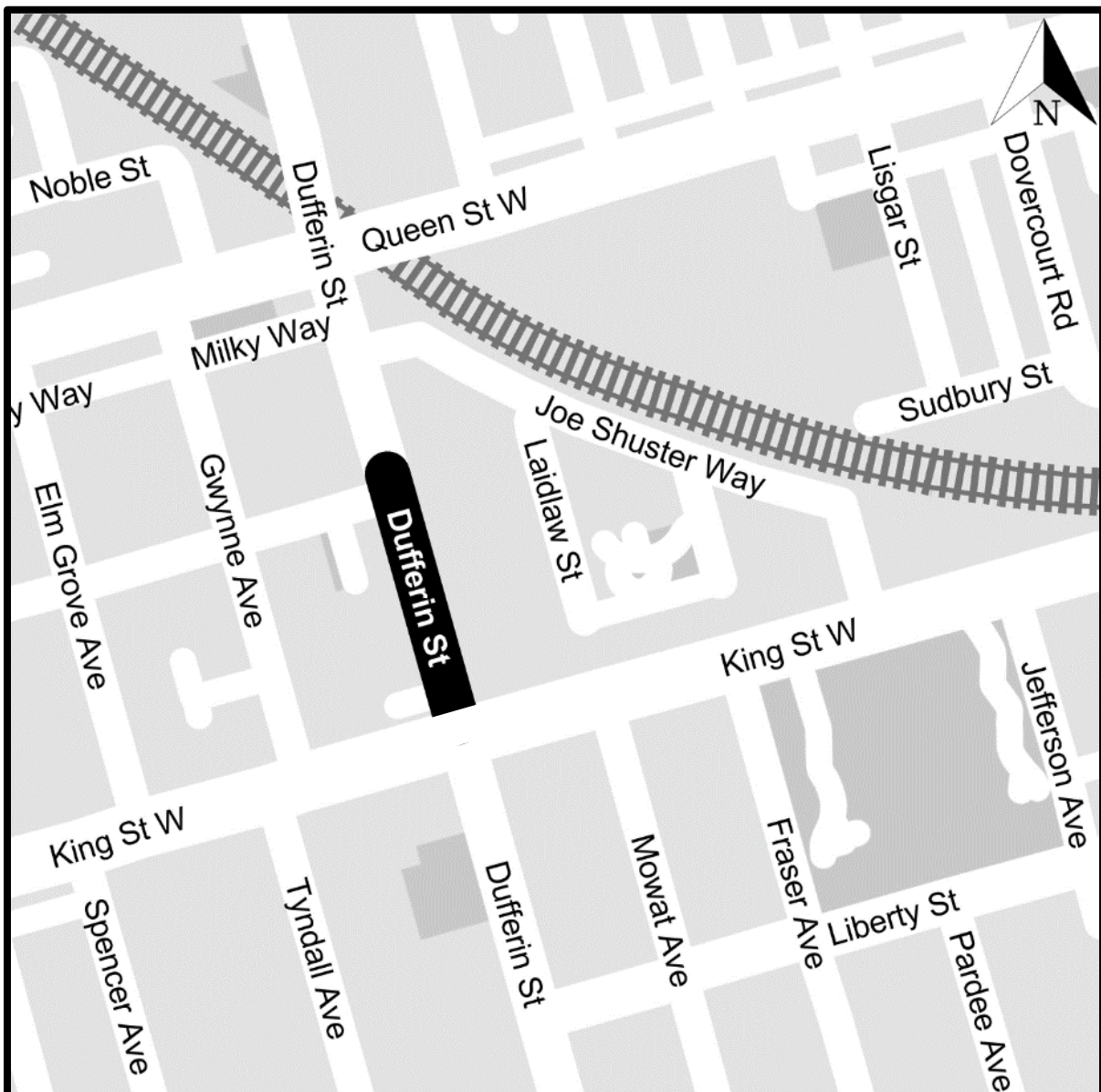
Road Repairs on Dufferin Street From 75m north of King Street to Melbourne Avenue

Contract: 17ECS-TI-24MR
Start Date: October 10, 2017
End Date: October 25, 2017

The City of Toronto is repairing the southbound curb lane on Dufferin Street from 75m north of King Street to Melbourne Avenue, to address some ongoing vibration issues that have affected nearby properties.

This work is part of the Council-approved 2017 Capital Works Program.

WORK DETAILS

The City's contractor will:

- Dig up the road base
- Repair the road foundations
- Restore the road.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road restrictions within the construction work zone. Sidewalks will be maintained on both sides of Dufferin Street during construction. Access for emergency vehicles will also be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Some of these efforts include adding Local Access signs, revising traffic signal times. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.</p> <p>Traffic on Dufferin Street will be reduced to one lane in each direction in the vicinity of the work.</p>
	<p>Parking: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner. If your vehicle is moved, please contact parking control for its location at 416-808-2222.</p>
	<p>Transit Service Impacts: This project may affect travel times for the 29 Dufferin Street route. Visit ttc.ca for further service details.</p>
	<p>Garbage & Recycling: Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. <i>Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.</i></p>
	<p>Restoration: Areas affected by construction will be restored.</p>
