## Watermain Replacement on Bathurst Street & Eireann Quay from Lakeshore Boulevard West

**Expected Start Date: September 2016**

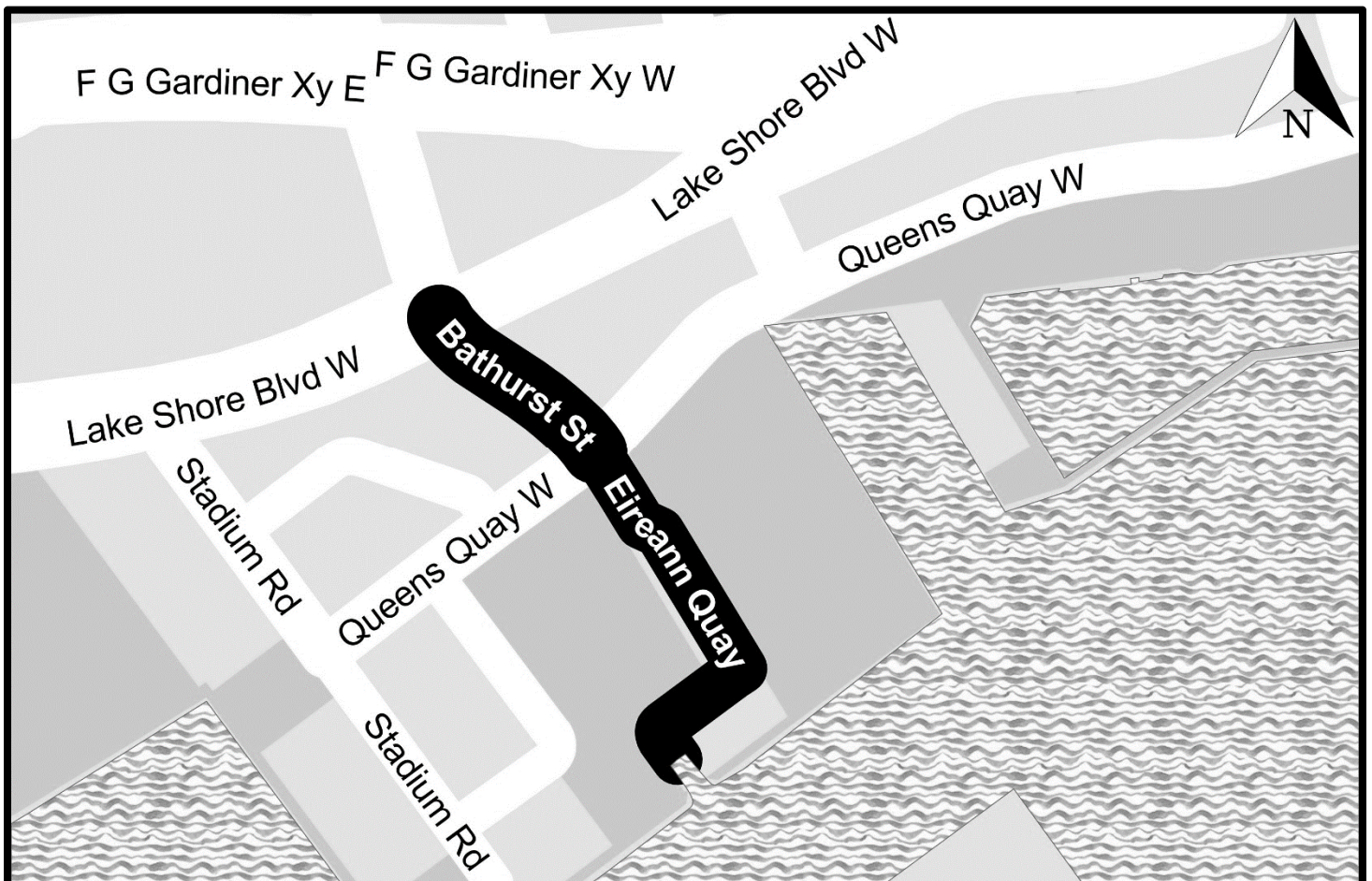
**Expected End Date: November 2016**

The City of Toronto is planning to replace the 1920s-era watermain with a new, larger watermain on Bathurst Street from Lakeshore Boulevard to Queen's Quay and on Eireann Quay.



This project is part of the Council-approved 2016 Capital Works Program to renew our aging infrastructure, improve water distribution and reduce the risk watermain breaks.

## WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark sidewalks and curbs requiring replacement and the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.
- Work in the boulevard in front of homes and commercial properties is expected. This work includes removing and replacing driveways, municipal sidewalks and grassed boulevards, where necessary.
- Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard), such as landscaping and or decorative objects before work starts. If you have a sprinkler system within the boulevard, please contact the Field Ambassador listed below.

	<p><b>Work Hours:</b> The work will generally take place from <b>10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. Sunday night to Friday night</b> with some work during the day on weekends as required (9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.).</p> <p>Overnight work allows the road to remain open and free of work during the day and reduces the interruption to TTC Streetcar service in the community.</p>
	<p><b>Accessible Accommodation:</b> Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, etc.) must contact the Project Manager to arrange for access during the construction period.</p>
