## High Level Substation Rehabilitation at 235 Cottingham Street

**Expected Start Date: Fall 2016**  
**Expected End Date: Summer 2017**

The City of Toronto is planning to rehabilitate the electrical substation located in the High Level Pumping Station Park beginning in the fall of 2016. This work will ensure that the substation continues to provide long-term reliable service, and is part of the Council-approved 2016 Capital Works Program.

### WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities. Crews will also post signs, install tree protection controls and temporary fencing. Some material and tools may be delivered to site as well.
- Properties in the surrounding area will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.
