## **Hoggs Hollow Phase 5 Storm Sewer, Watermain Replacement and Road Reconstruction on Plymbridge Cres and Plymbridge Rd**

In early spring 2016, the City will start Phase 5 of our work in the Hoggs Hollow neighbourhood. The work involves installing a new storm sewer, replacing the watermain and road reconstruction on Plymbridge Crescent and Plymbridge Road from the Don River Bridge to # 67 Plymbridge Road.

This project is part of the Council-approved 2016 Capital Works Program that will reduce the risk of flooding, improve water distribution and the City's aging infrastructure.

We invite you to attend a meeting with City staff to learn more about the Phase 5 work and discuss the traffic management plan.

### **WORK DETAILS**

The construction work will take place in four stages over six months.

Stage 1	Storm sewer & watermain installation on Plymbridge Rd.	<b>March to April</b>
Stage 2	Watermain installation on Plymbridge Crescent	<b>May to June</b>
Stage 3	Storm sewer installation on Plymbridge Crescent	<b>June to July</b>
Stage 4	Road reconstruction of roads on all streets	<b>July to August</b>


As with all construction projects there will be temporary inconveniences. In order to complete the work effectively and in a safe manner, some pedestrian and traffic restrictions will be necessary.

In order to maintain access along Plymbridge Road, the following measures will be used:

- Within the construction zone, one lane of traffic will be maintained at all times.
- Traffic flow will be monitored and coordinated by two certified Traffic Control persons.
- The Contractor will use extended work hours to minimize traffic disruption and to shorten the project duration.

- Work will take place on Plymbridge Road between 9:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m., weekdays.
- On Plymbridge Crescent work will take place between 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. as required.
- During the final stage of work in July and August, road paving will be completed weekends from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- The City has arranged with Hillcrest School to provide bus service to pick-up and drop-off students at a nearby location to reduce the number of vehicles entering the construction area.
- If required, the City will also have a paid-duty officer on-site during construction.
