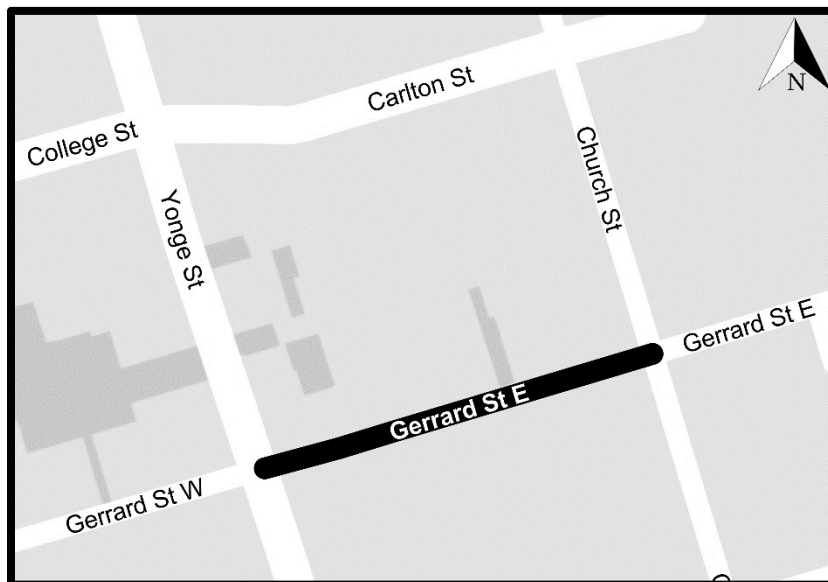
## Road Reconstruction on Gerrard Street East between Yonge Street and Church Street

Contract: 16ECS-TI-15SP

This notice provides an update on construction activities taking place on Gerrard Street East between Yonge Street and Church Street.

**On September 2, 2016, work will start at 4:00 A.M. and continue to 7:00 P.M.**

### WORK DETAILS

- The work starting at 4:00 A.M. will be disruptive because it involves grinding and milling the concrete and asphalt surfaces at the intersections of Gerrard Street East at Yonge and Church Streets.
- Once the milling is completed, crews will lay the base and top asphalt along Gerrard Street East from Yonge Street to Church Street.
- Work is starting at 4:00 A.M. in order to complete the operation in one day and reduce the impact on traffic operations through the intersections.




#### **Working Hours on September 2:**

4:00 A.M to 8:00 A.M – Milling of the roadway at the intersections

8:00 A.M. to 7:00 P.M – Base and Top Asphalt Paving



**Regular work hours of 7:00 A.M. to 7:00 P.M. will resume on Tuesday, September 6.**

	<p><b>Traffic Management:</b></p> <p>The work requires lane closures at the intersections of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Yonge Street and Gerrard Street East</li> <li>• Church Street and Gerrard Street East</li> </ul> <p><b><i>One lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction at all times through the affected intersections and on Gerrard Street East.</i></b></p>

**WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION**

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	<p><b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions in the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p><b>Driveway Access:</b> The contractor will notify you of any restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p><b>Cyclist Information:</b> <i>Due to the nature of the work on Gerrard Street, there is not enough road width to complete construction and maintain cycling lanes in the work zones.</i> Cyclists are encouraged to share the lane through the phased, construction work zones.</p> <p>Alternatively, Cyclists may choose to adjust their routes, so that they travel on Wellesley Street instead.</p>
