Combined Sewer Replacement on Mutual Street from Queen Street East to Shuter Street & Road Resurfacing from Queen Street East to Dundas Street East

Contract: 16ECS-LU-14SU

Start Date: June 2016

End Date: November 2016

The City is replacing the combined sewer along Mutual Street from Queen Street East to Shuter Street. This work will also involve replacing the City-owned portion of substandard water services and the sanitary laterals. The contractor will also resurface Mutual Street from Queen Street East to Dundas Street East.

The sanitary service lateral is the pipe connecting your property's plumbing to the City's sewer, the water service underground pipe brings water to your water property; both of these pipes are owned by you and by the City. The part that you own is from your building to the end of your property, the part the City owns goes from the sewer and watermain to your property line.

This project is part of the Council-approved 2016 Capital Works Program to improve water distribution, renew aging infrastructure reducing the risk of sewer collapse or blockages that cause sewer backups and rehabilitate and upgrade our roads for current and future needs.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT LEAD WATER SERVICES


If you live in a building that was built before the mid-1950s, your water service may be made of lead. Please read the attached fact sheet with important information about the risks of lead in drinking water, especially if someone in your house is pregnant, there are children under six years old, or there is an infant drinking formula made from tap water.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark sidewalks and curbs to be replaced and underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable.
- A Construction Notice will be delivered to the entire community approximately two weeks before work begins with an exact start date and details about the work.
- Further notice will be provided to property owners who must remove items located within City property limits (boulevard), such as decorative objects. If you have a sprinkler system within the boulevard, please contact the Field Ambassador listed below.

	<p>Substandard Water Service Replacement: Please read the attached fact sheet as it contains important information about lead in drinking water and water service replacement. Find out if your water service is lead – a licensed plumber can help you with this. If it is lead, the City of Toronto encourages you to replace it. We recommend you obtain several quotes and you can contact the City's contractor for one of your quotes.
