**Contract: 16ECS-TI-12LR**

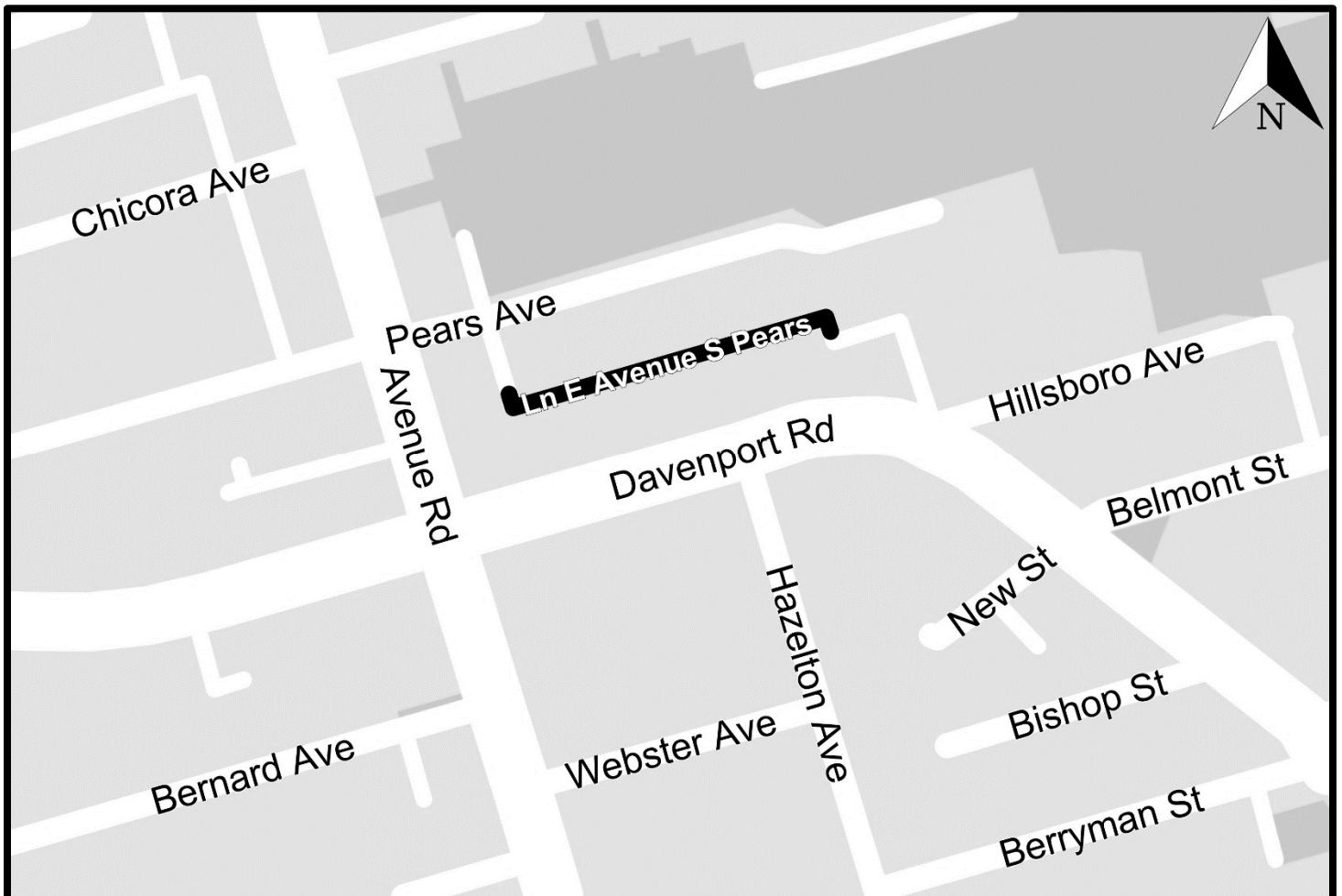
**Expected Start Date: November 16, 2016**

The City of Toronto will be doing warranty repairs on the laneway located south of Pears Avenue, north of Davenport Road and east of Avenue Road.

## WORK DETAILS



The City’s contractor will move equipment on-site and prepare the work area before construction begins. Construction crews will then:

- Seal cracks in concrete that are related to warranty work.
- Remove and replace concrete that is related to warranty work.
- Restore all areas affected by work (asphalt, concrete, grass, etc.)

## WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You will experience dust, noise and other inconveniences.
- Property owners should remove items located within City property limits, such as landscaping and / or decorative objects.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.
- The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. Your patience is appreciated.

	<p><b>Work Hours:</b> Work will take place from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
	<p><b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p>
	<p><b>Traffic Management:</b> Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents.</p> <p><b>The laneway will be closed for approximately 7 days (or less) during the construction period.</b></p>
	<p><b>Parking:</b> Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner. If your vehicle is moved, please contact parking control for its location at <b>416-808-2222</b>.</p> <p><b><u>NOTE: Unfortunately temporary parking permits are not available, please arrange for an alternative parking location.</u></b></p>
	<p><b>Garbage &amp; Recycling:</b> Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them.</p> <p><b>Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.</b></p>

	<p><b>Restoration:</b> The construction work area will be restored with sod and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed from public and private property during construction will be replaced.</p>
	<p><b>Accessible Accommodation:</b> Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, etc.) must contact the <b>Field Ambassador</b> to arrange for access during the construction period.</p>
