
The City of Toronto is planning to replace the watermain and approximately 200 City-owned portions of substandard water services on Ferris Road from Rexleigh Drive to Dawes Road; Druid Court from Ferris Road to the north end and Cedarcrest Boulevard between Glen Albert and Ferris Road.

The water service is the underground pipe that brings water to your water meter and is owned by you and by the City. The part you own is from your house to the end of your property, the part the City owns is from the end of your property to the water main. This project is part of the Council-approved 2015 Capital Works Program that will improve water distribution and the City's aging infrastructure while reducing the risk of watermain breaks.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT LEAD WATER SERVICES

If you live in a house built before the mid-1950s, your water service may be lead. Please read the attached fact sheet as it contains important information about the risks of lead water services, especially if someone in your house is pregnant, there are children under six years old, or there is an infant drinking formula made from tap water.

WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark sidewalks and curbs to be replaced and underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable.
- In the coming weeks, approximately 200 properties affected by Substandard Water Service Replacements will receive an invitation to a public meeting (**date to be confirmed**) to learn more about this work, the potential for lead exposure and what arrangements affected property owners can make to replace their portion of substandard water services.
- A Construction Notice will be delivered to the entire community approximately two weeks before work begins with an exact start date and details about the work.
- Further notice will be provided to property owners who must remove items located within City property limits (boulevard), such as decorative objects. If you have a sprinkler system within the boulevard, please contact the Field Ambassador listed below.

	<p>Substandard Water Service Replacement: Please read the attached fact sheet as it contains important information about lead in drinking water and water service replacement. Find out if your water service is lead – a licensed plumber can help you with this. If it is lead, the City of Toronto encourages you to replace it. We recommend you obtain several quotes and you can contact the City's contractor for one of your quotes.
