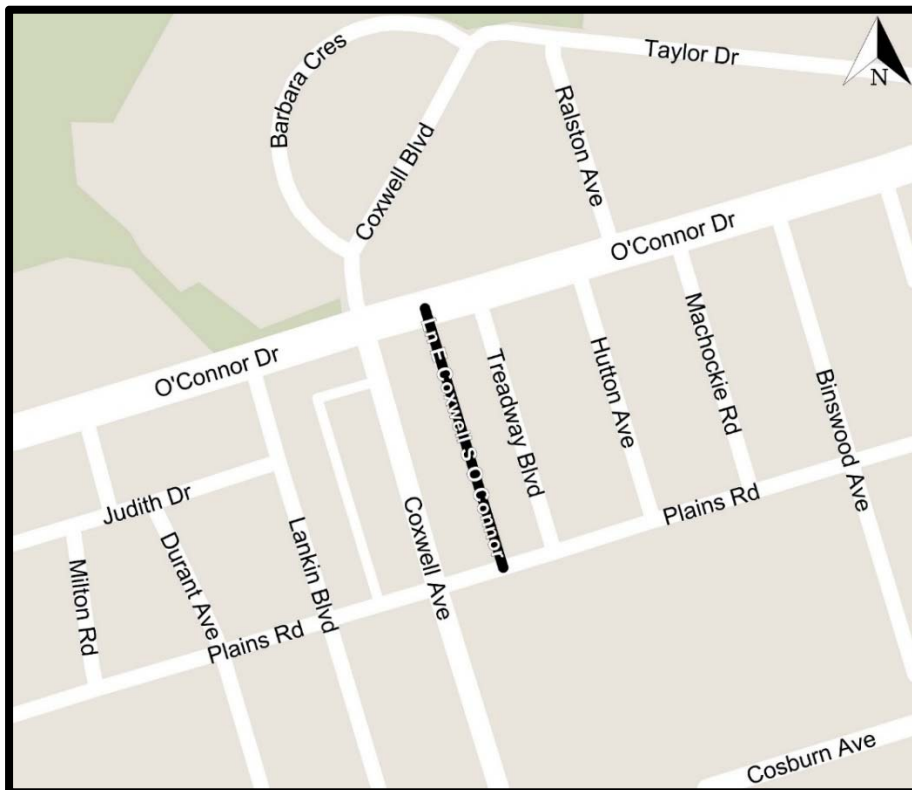
Laneway Reconstruction (West of Treadway Boulevard) from O'Connor Drive to Plains Road

Contract: 15ECS-LU-14SU
Revised Start Date: May 2, 2016
End Date: June 30, 2016
**Timeline is subject to change.*

In October 2015, a construction notice was delivered informing you that the City will reconstruct the laneway between Coxwell Avenue and Treadway Boulevard from O'Connor Drive to Plains Road. To accommodate the work, there will be ongoing laneway closures along this laneway and along O'Connor Drive while crews complete the laneway reconstruction.

We recognize that this type of work is disruptive to the community and will take all necessary measures to mitigate the impacts. We appreciate your patience.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- See the table on page 2 for parking information.
- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. Your patience is appreciated.
- Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard), such as landscaping and / or decorative objects. The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>

	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be parking, road and sidewalk restrictions within and near the construction work area.</p> <p>Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Accommodation: Residents that require accommodation must contact the Field Ambassador to arrange for access during the construction period.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.</p> <p>Construction may result in temporary closures of the laneway and / or private driveways.</p>
	<p>Parking: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner. Please contact parking control for the location of your vehicle at 416-808-2222.</p> <p><i>In the event you receive a traffic ticket for on-street parking during this period of construction, please immediately contact the Field Ambassador listed below, so that your tickets can be cancelled.</i></p> <p>Please note that parking tickets cannot be cancelled if vehicles have parked in illegal parking spots such as hydrant violations or no parking zones or if they are submitted to the Construction Inspector later than three days of receipt.</p> <p>For the duration of construction, parking will be reduced to a single car length depth to accommodate a temporary parallel drive aisle. Residents who regularly park near the laneway and require additional parking, are asked to park on Plains Road. For afterhours / overnight parking, please use Coxwell Avenue.</p>
	<p>Garbage & Recycling: Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. <i>Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.</i></p>
	<p>Restoration: The construction work area will be restored with sod and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed during construction will be replaced. Lawn seeding and/or laying of sod will be done as needed during ideal growing seasons only - in the spring (April to June) and fall (September to October). The contractor will provide permanent restoration under this contract.</p>
