

On May 3, 2016, City Council made a series of decisions related to taxicab, limousine and Private Transportation Company (PTC) regulations. Below are the changes that take **effect immediately**, as well as the ones that will take effect as of **July 15, 2016**.

IMMEDIATE CHANGES

Questions	Answers
I want to own a limousine. Is training required?	Limousine owners no longer need to take City-run training as a condition of licensing. This means that both initial and refresher training are no longer required.
Am I required to do CPR and First Aid training?	No. CPR and First Aid Training are no longer required as a condition of licensing.
Why do I need to obtain a Vehicle-for-hire driver's licence to drive my Limousine?	The new Vehicle-for-hire Bylaw separates the roles and responsibilities of limousine owners from limousine drivers. The bylaw requires that limousine owners who wish to drive their taxicab must obtain a Vehicle-for-hire driver's licence. The new licence costs \$130 per year and does not require additional training. A limousine owner who does not drive does not need to obtain this licence.
How long can my limousine stay on the road?	Sedans can now stay on the road for seven (7) model years and be put on the road at any time within the seven years. The vehicle can carry up to seven (7) passengers.
Are there any changes involving stretch limousines?	No. City Council did not approve changes to stretch limousines.
