

On May 3, 2016, City Council made a series of decisions related to taxicab, limousine and Private Transportation Company (PTC) regulations. The changes will take effect as of July 15, 2016.

Questions	Answers
<p>What training is required for limousine drivers?</p>	<p>At this time, Limousine drivers no longer need to take City-run training as a condition of licensing. This means that both initial and refresher training are not required, now, or after July 15, 2016.</p>
<p>Am I required to do CPR and First Aid training?</p>	<p>No. CPR and First Aid Training are not required as a condition of licensing, now or after July 15, 2016.</p>
<p>Does my limousine licence change?</p>	<p>As of July 15, 2016, your licence will change to a new Vehicle-for-Hire (VfH) licence which will allow you to drive either a taxicab or a limousine. At your next licence renewal, a new licence with "Vehicle-for-Hire Driver" will be issued to you instead of a "Limousine Driver" licence.</p>
<p>I am licensed as both a taxicab and limousine driver. How will my licences be transitioned to the new Vehicle-for-Hire Driver's Licence?</p>	<p>Your driver's licence that is due to be renewed next (either the taxi or limo licence) will be cancelled. The remaining licence will permit you to operate as either a taxicab or limousine. You will be sent a Licence Renewal Notice before the expiry date of your remaining driver's licence. Once renewed, you will be issued a VFH drivers licence that will continue to give you permission to operate both a taxicab and a limousine.</p>
