### **Community Meeting**

The City of Toronto and Lanterra Developments are undertaking an 8 month design process for a new public park at 11 Wellesley Street West. The new park will be a 1.6 acre L-shaped park bordered by Wellesley Street West to the north, Breadalbane Street to the south and St. Luke Lane to the east. The land is currently under private ownership but will be conveyed to the City of Toronto as public parkland following the completion of the development and the construction of the park.

City Staff and Lanterra Developments are hosting a community meeting to:

- Introduce the project scope and timeline;
- Present and seek community feedback on preliminary park design concepts; and
- Highlight project next steps.
