In the fall of 2008, the City of Toronto and the Toronto Cyclists Union asked for suggestions on how to improve cycling conditions in the area south of Bloor Street bounded by Bathurst Street, the Gardiner Expressway, and Parkside Drive. We received nearly 70 responses and held a subsequent meeting and conducted a cycling audit, with those who submitted ideas, to review potential bikeway projects. City staff would now like to discuss the next steps of this work.
